## **Maine** Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Maine account for 9.87 percent of the total output in the state, employing 8.3 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$5.59 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 51,000 manufacturing employees in Maine in 2016, with an average annual compensation of \$63,175 in 2015.

Figure 1: Maine Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015





Figure 2: Top 10 Maine Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014




## **Maine** Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Maine's economy, with \$1.79 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2016. That same year, \$0.74 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 17.10 percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 83.0 percent of all exporters in Maine.
