West Virginia Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in West Virginia account for 10.07 percent of the total output in the state, employing 6.2 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$7.43 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 47,100 manufacturing employees in West Virginia in 2016, with an average annual compensation of \$67,399 in 2015.

Figure 1: West Virginia Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015





Figure 2: Top 10 West Virginia Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014




West Virginia Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive West Virginia's economy, with \$3.67 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2016. That same year, \$1.80 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 20.60 percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 76.0 percent of all exporters in West Virginia.
