

# Georgia Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Georgia account for 10.97 percent of the total output in the state, employing 8.78 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$52.25 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 373,600 manufacturing employees in Georgia in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$65,817 in 2013.

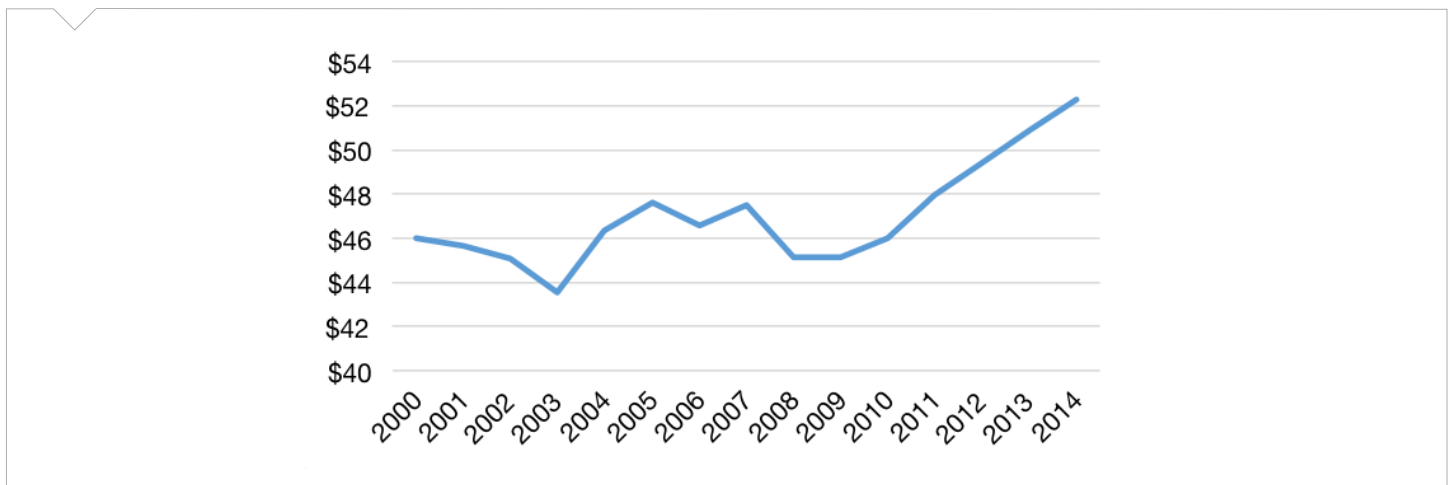

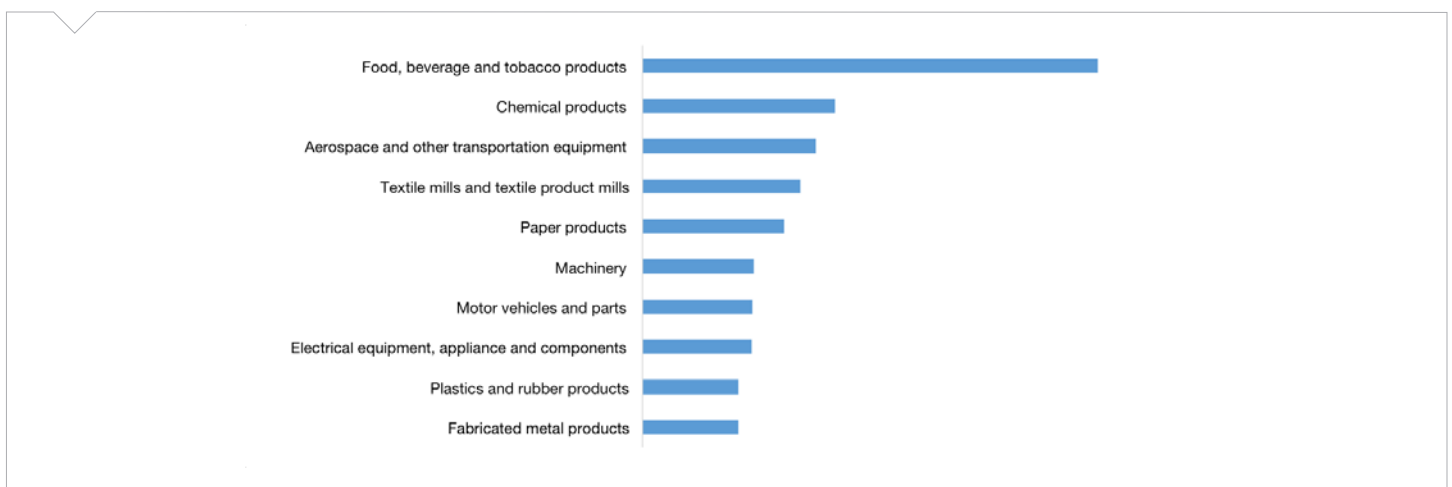

**Figure 2:** Top 10 Georgia Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



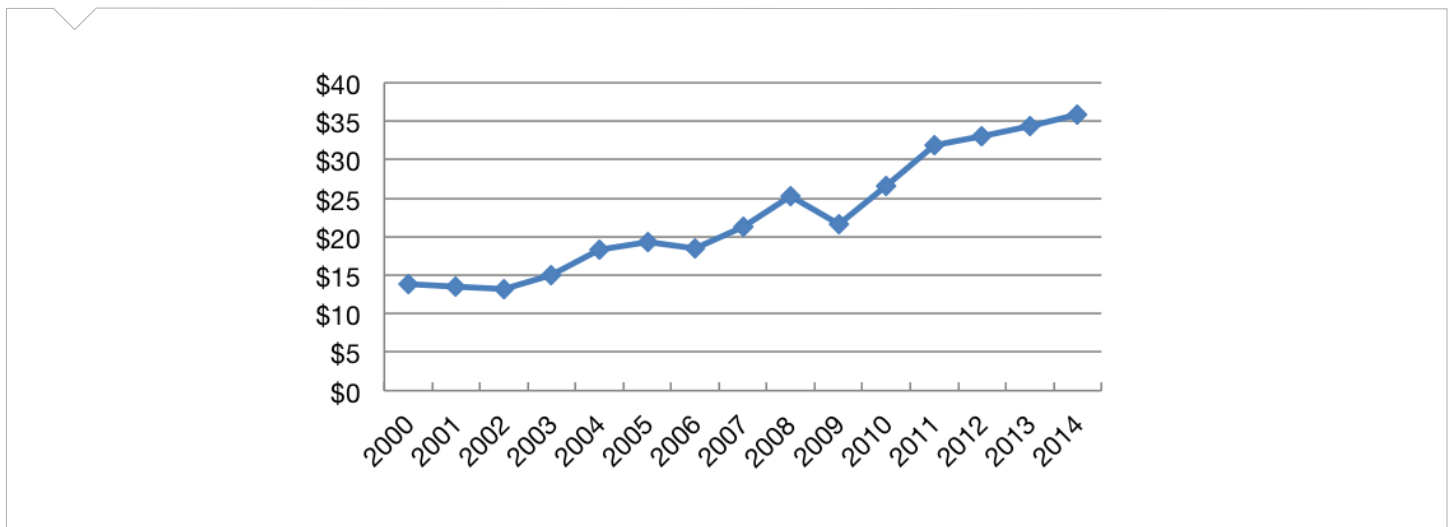
# Georgia Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Georgia's economy, with \$35.93 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$13.45 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 21.30% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 88.8 percent of all exporters in Georgia.

## Additional Trade Facts

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
