

# Maryland Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Maryland account for 5.81 percent of the total output in the state, employing 3.84 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$19.89 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 102,000 manufacturing employees in Maryland in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$80,310 in 2013.

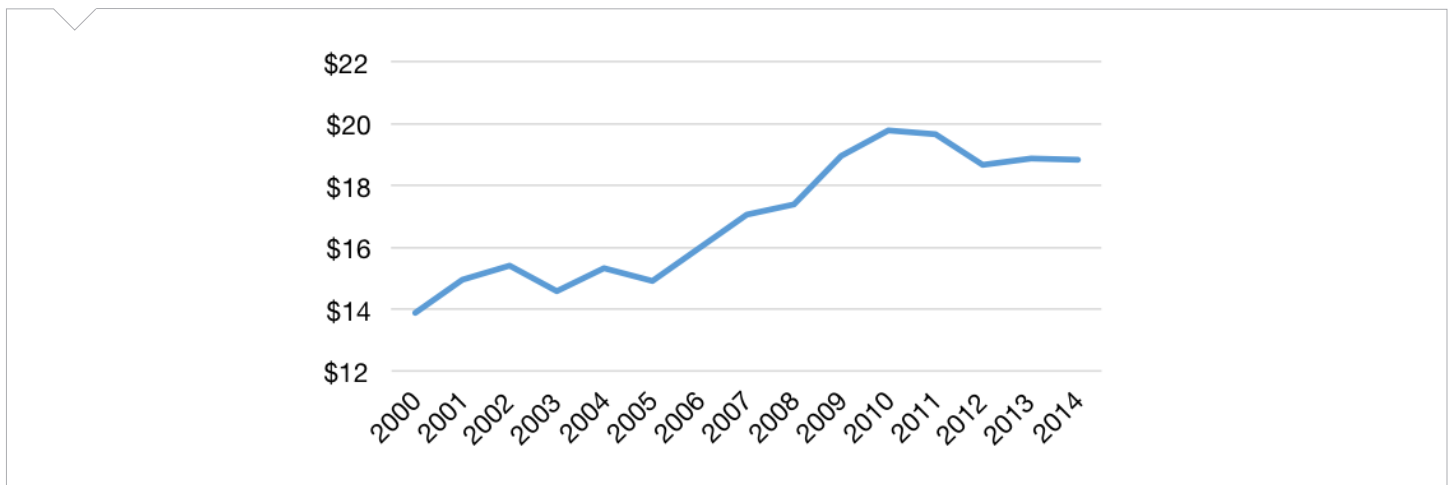

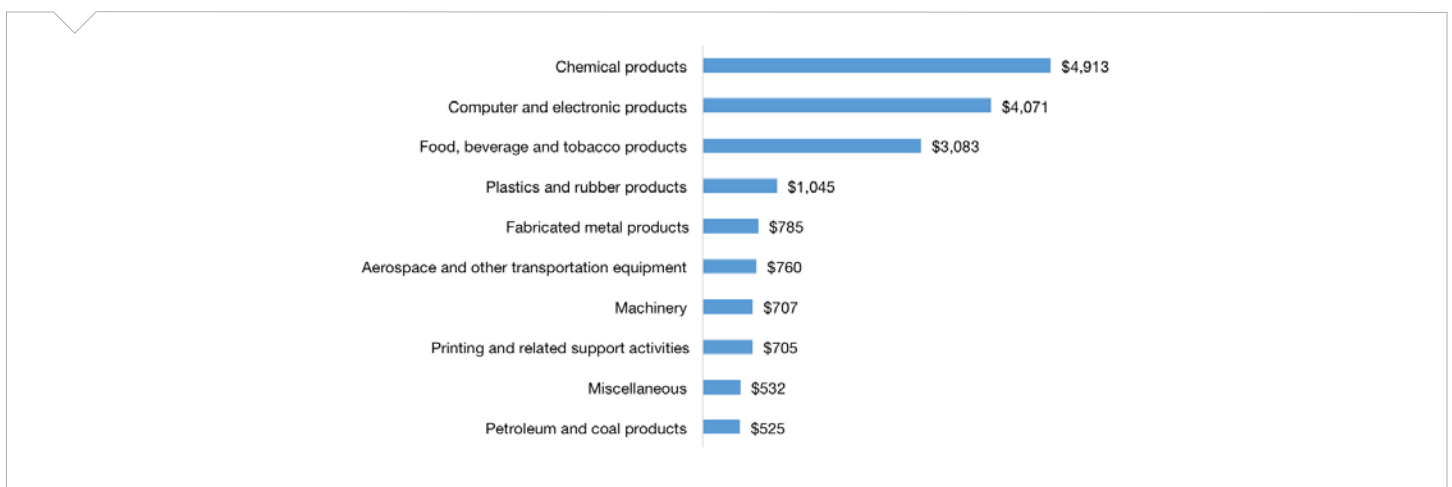

**Figure 2:** Top 10 Maryland Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



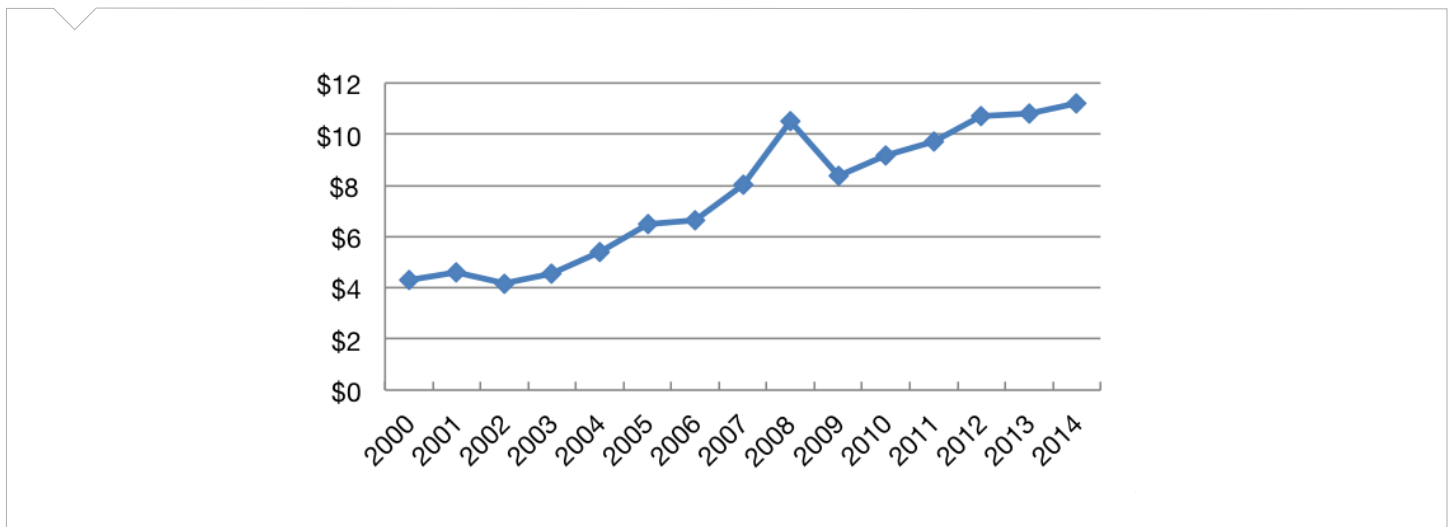
# Maryland Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Maryland's economy, with \$11.19 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$3.62 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 13.20% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 88.4 percent of all exporters in Maryland.

## Additional Trade Facts

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
- FTA countries: Australia, Bahrain, Canada, Chile, Columbia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Jordan, Mexico, Morocco, Nicaragua, Oman, Panama, Peru, Singapore and South Korea.
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
