

Nevada Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Nevada account for 4.42 percent of the total output in the state, employing 3.35 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$5.84 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 42,100 manufacturing employees in Nevada in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$61,360 in 2013.

Figure 1: Nevada Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

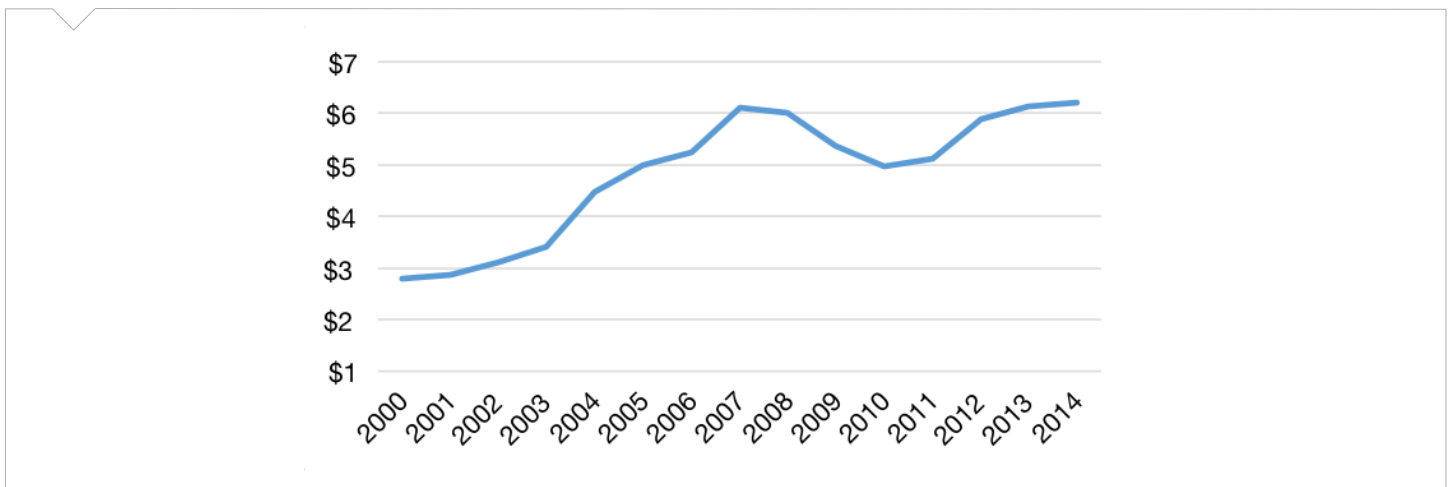
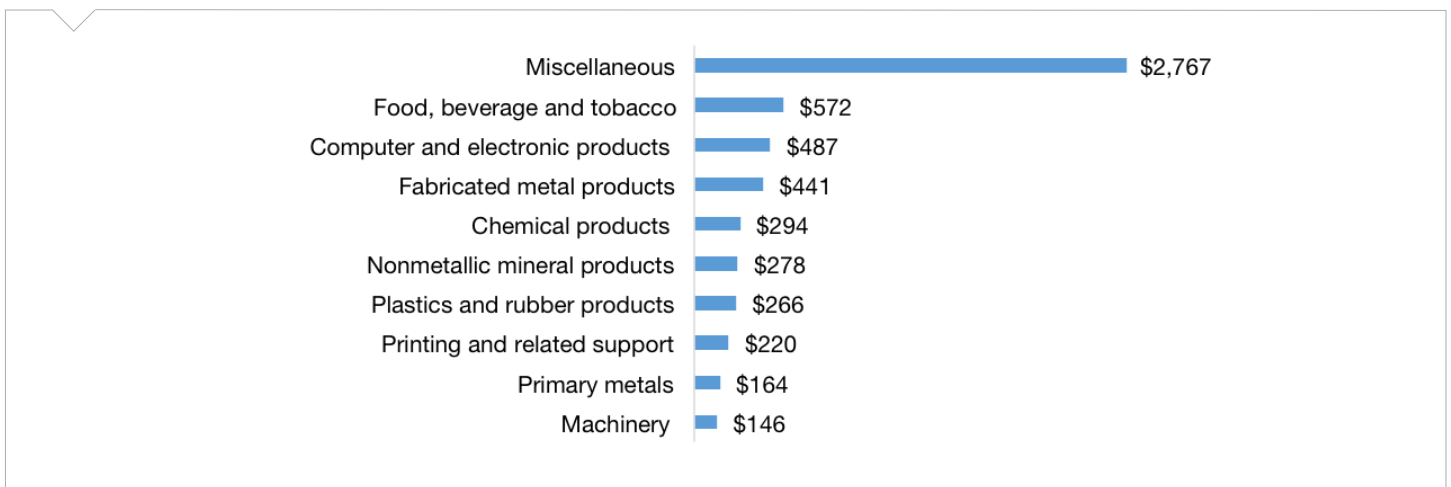


Figure 2: Top 10 Nevada Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



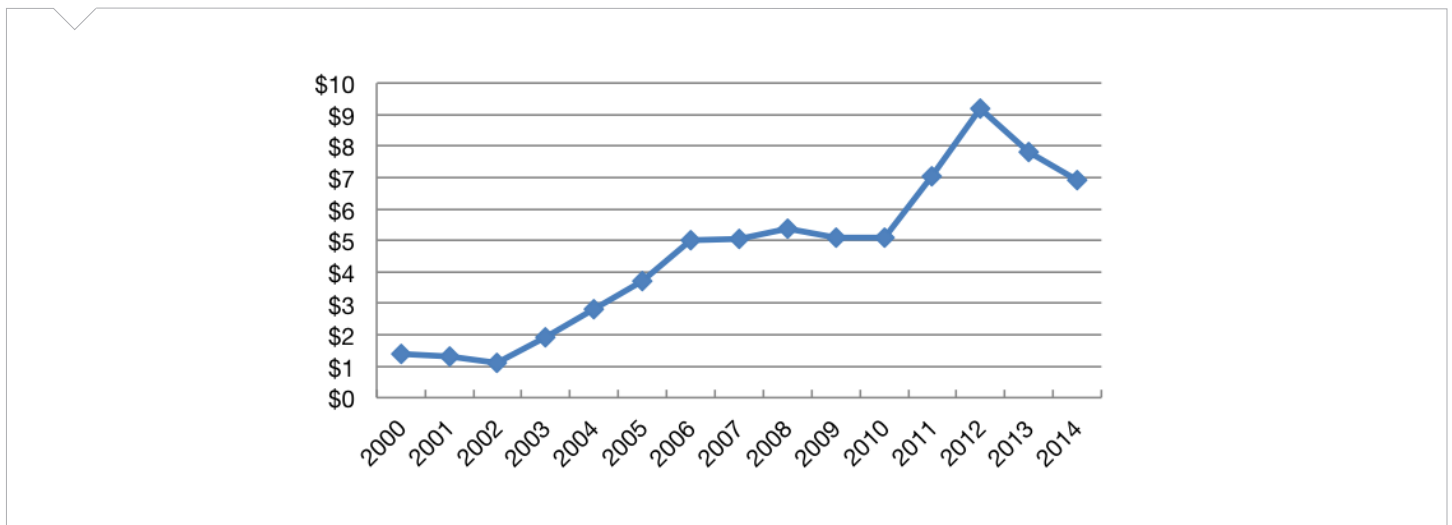
Nevada Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Nevada's economy, with \$6.92 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$1.97 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 17.40% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 85 percent of all exporters in Nevada.

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
