

Ohio Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Ohio account for 16.92 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.8 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$98.69 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 690,600 manufacturing employees in Ohio in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$69,551 in 2013.

Figure 1: Ohio Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

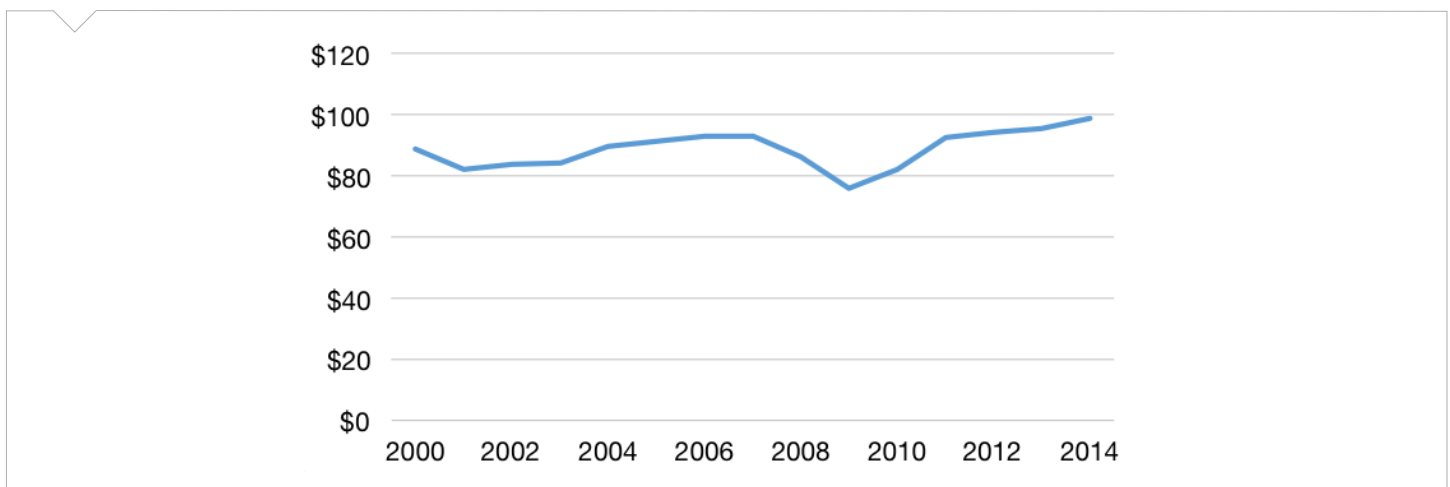
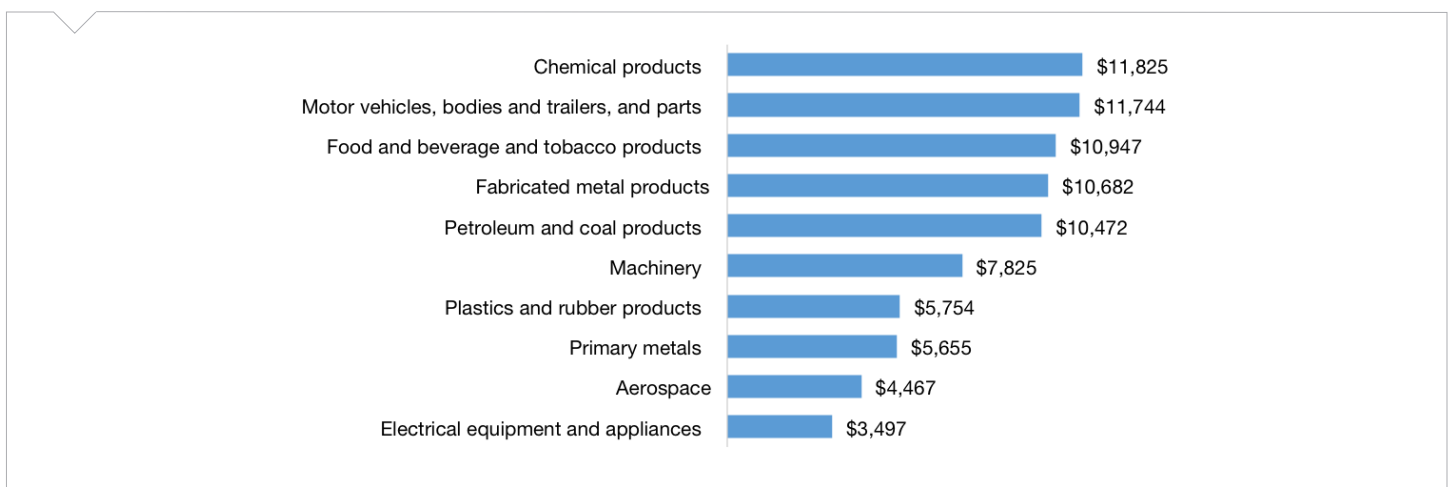


Figure 2: Top 10 Ohio Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



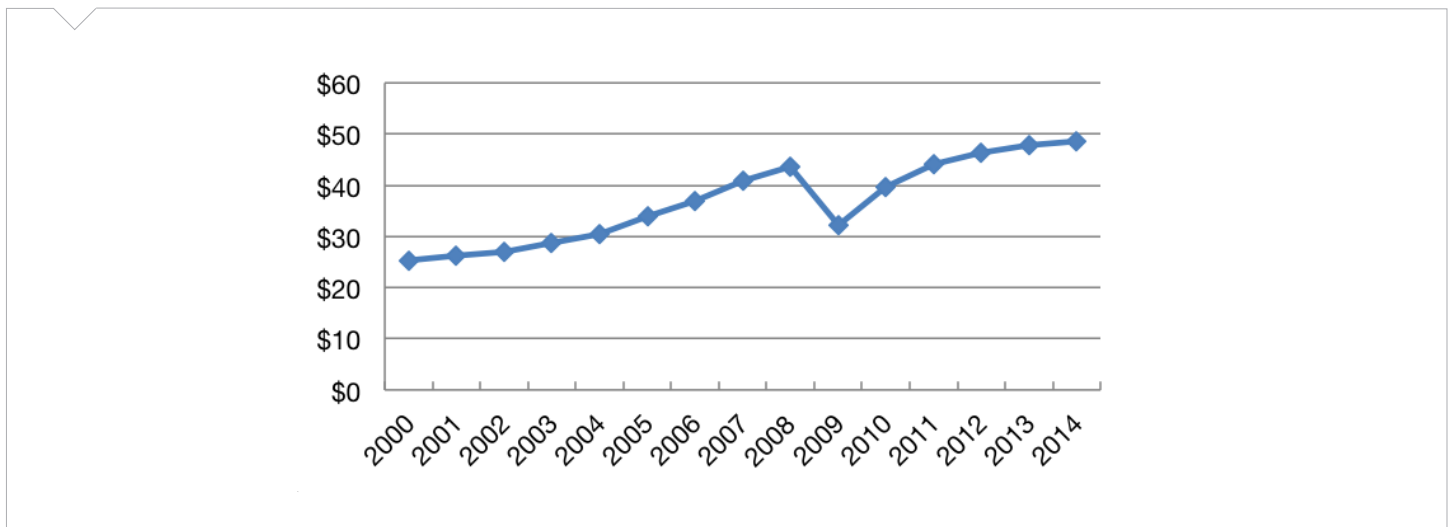
Ohio Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Ohio's economy, with \$48.57 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$29.52 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 27.60% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 89.3 percent of all exporters in Ohio.

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
