

Oregon Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Oregon account for 25.87 percent of the total output in the state, employing 10.54 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$55.79 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 186,600 manufacturing employees in Oregon in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$71,603 in 2013.

Figure 1: Oregon Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

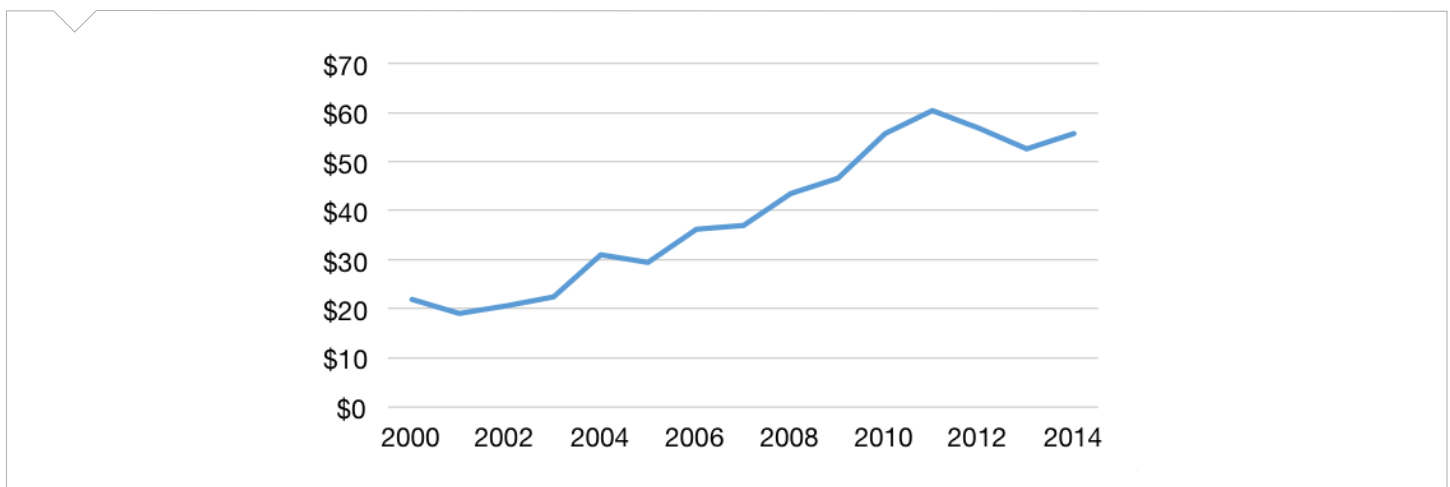
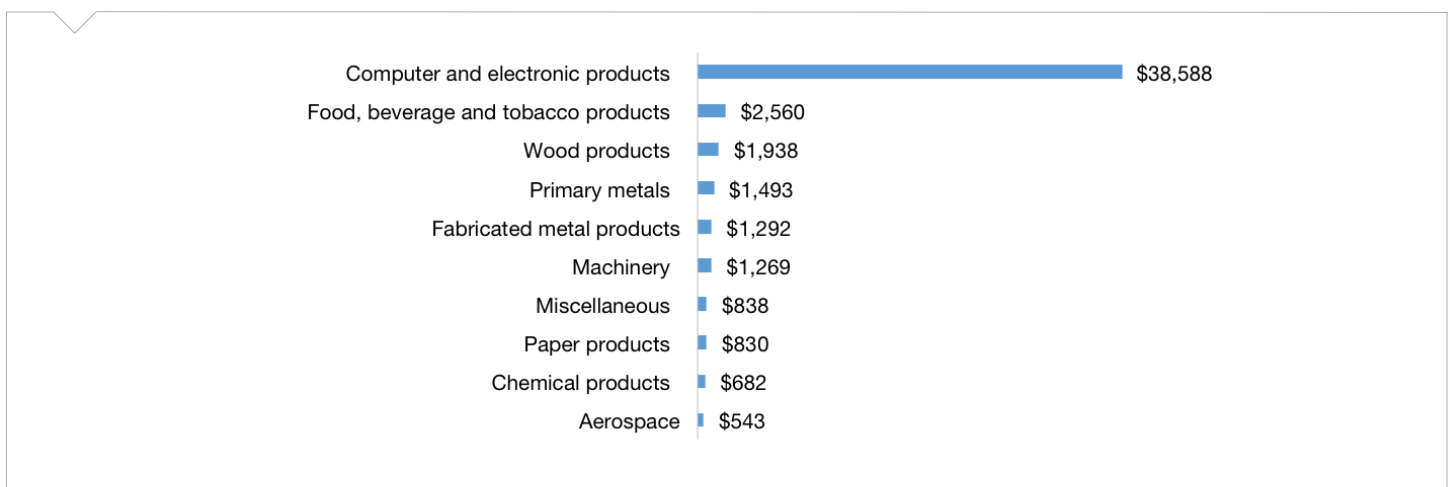


Figure 2: Top 10 Oregon Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



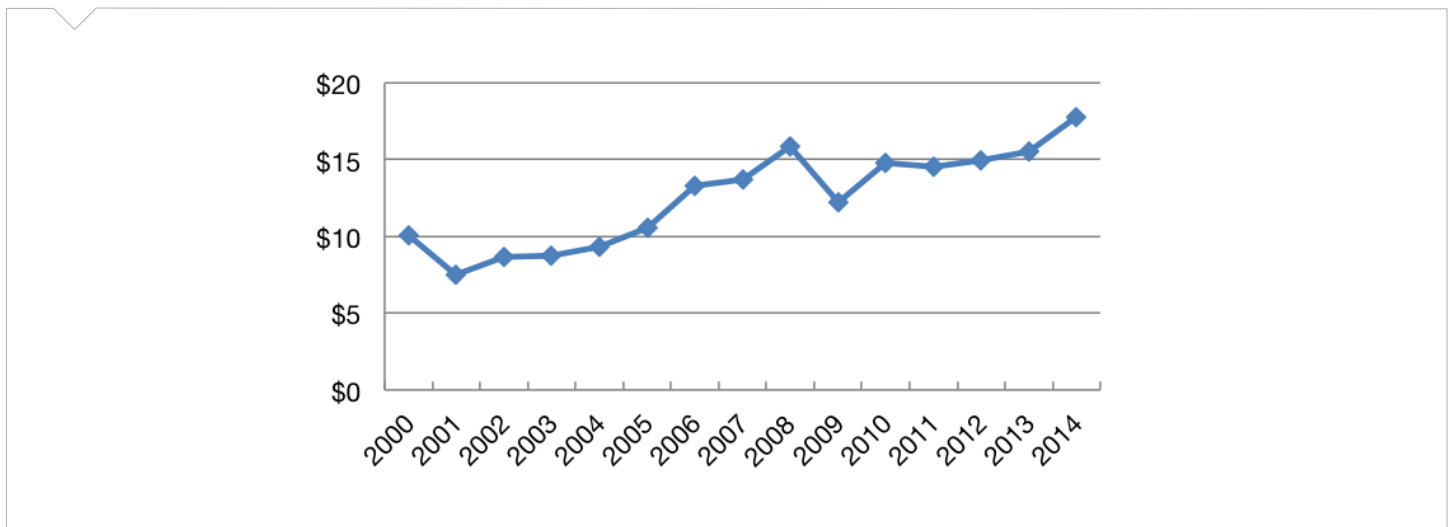
Oregon Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Oregon's economy, with \$17.80 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$5.46 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 22.00% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 88.1 percent of all exporters in Oregon.

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
