

Kentucky Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Kentucky account for 19.2 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.7 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$36.18 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 240,200 manufacturing employees in Kentucky in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$66,287 in 2014.

Figure 1: Kentucky Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

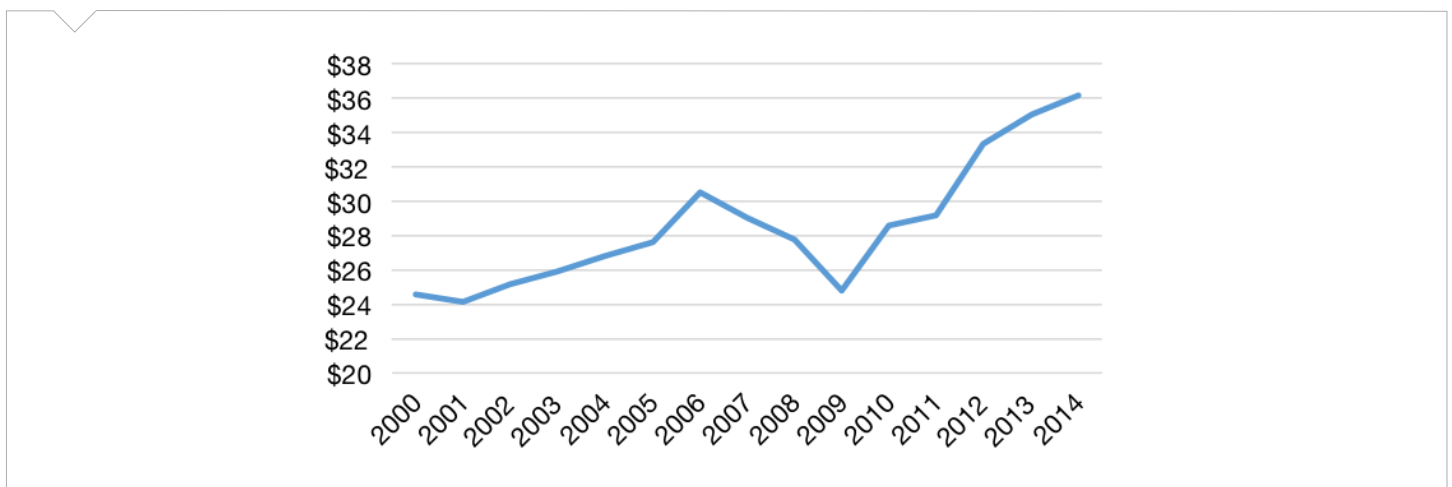
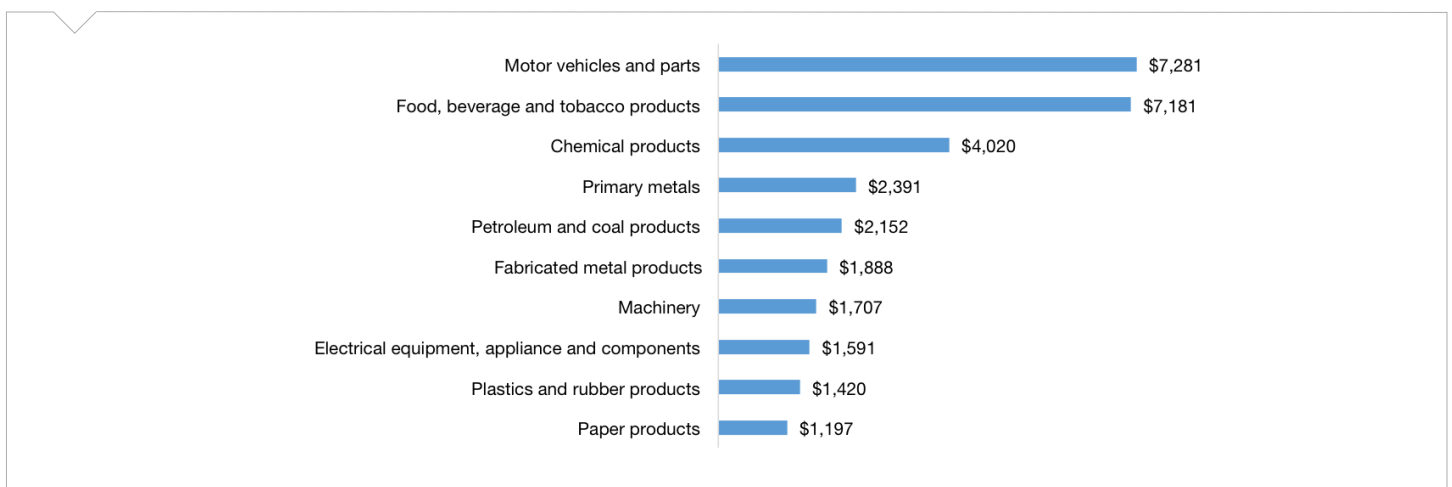


Figure 2: Top 10 Kentucky Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



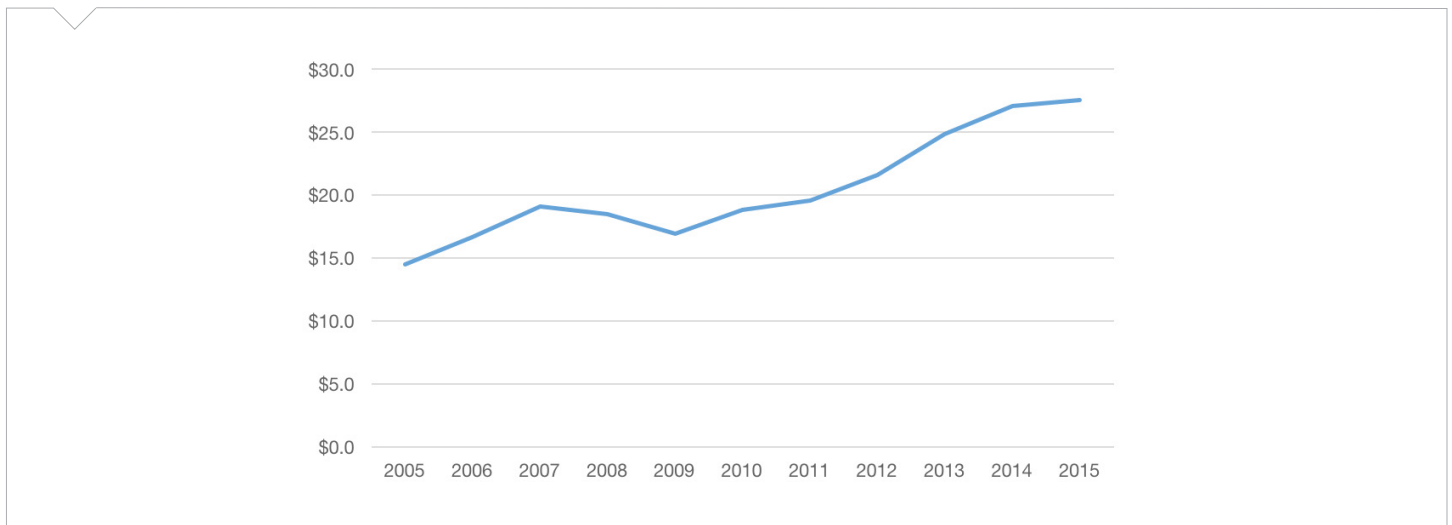
Kentucky Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Kentucky's economy, with \$27.58 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$11.51 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 23.5% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 79.5 percent of all exporters in Kentucky.

Additional Trade Facts

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
