

# Mississippi Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Mississippi account for 14.4 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.5 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$15.13 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 141,000 manufacturing employees in Mississippi in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$57,303 in 2014.

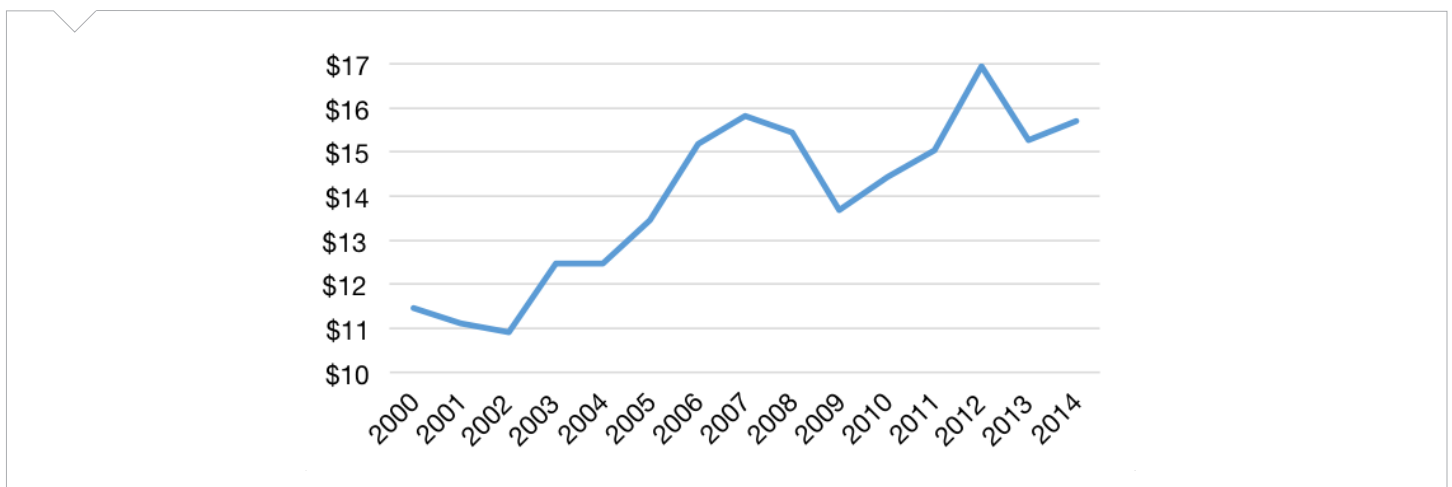

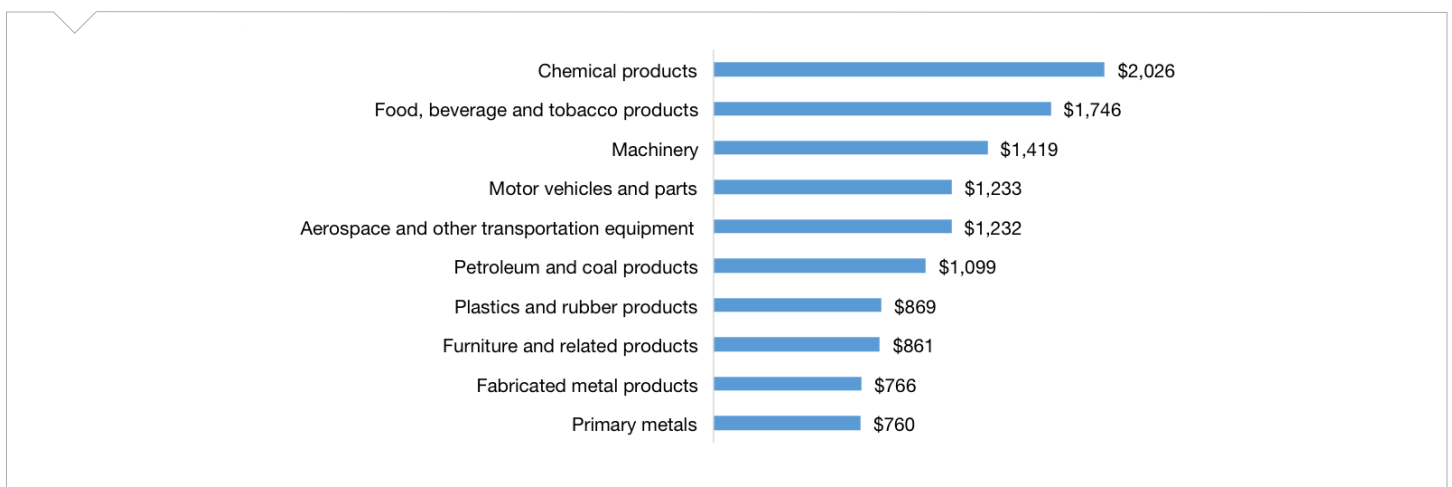

**Figure 2:** Top 10 Mississippi Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



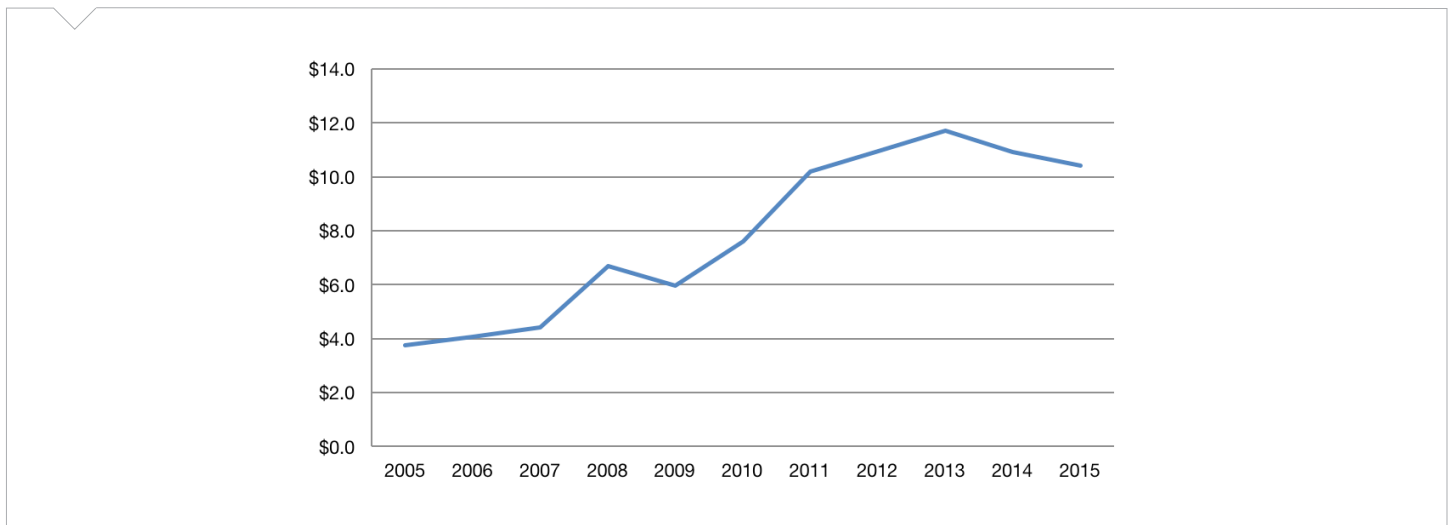
# Mississippi Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Mississippi's economy, with \$10.40 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$6.47 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 13.6% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 76.2 percent of all exporters in Mississippi.

## Additional Trade Facts

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
- FTA countries: Australia, Bahrain, Canada, Chile, Columbia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Jordan, Mexico, Morocco, Nicaragua, Oman, Panama, Peru, Singapore and South Korea.
