

Ohio Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Ohio account for 16.9 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.7 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$98.69 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 688,200 manufacturing employees in Ohio in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$71,178 in 2014.

Figure 1: Ohio Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

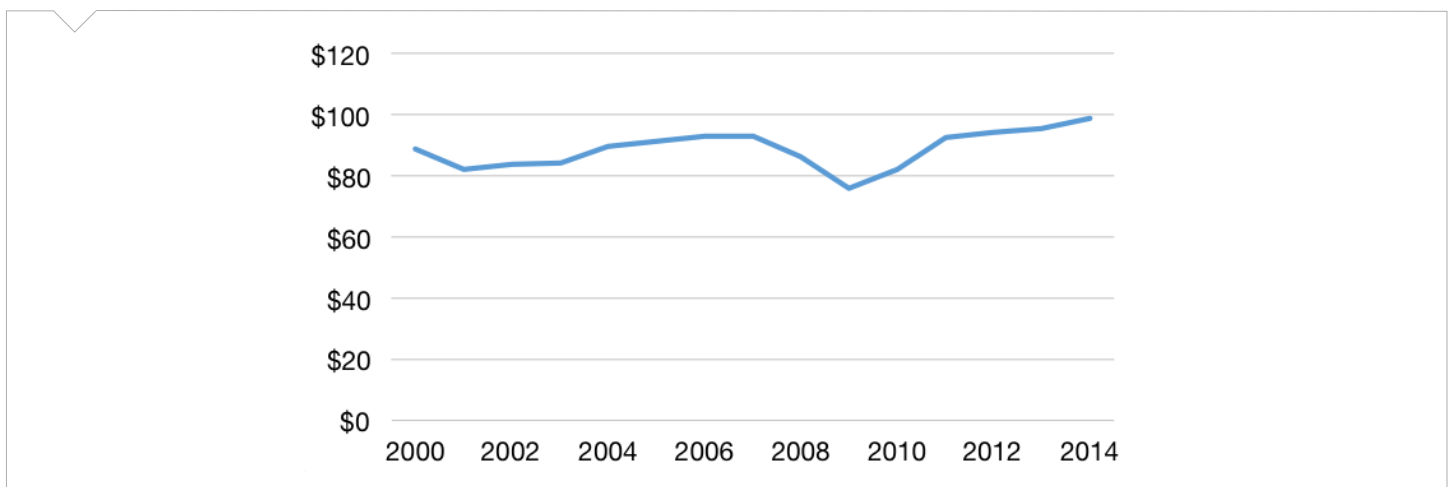
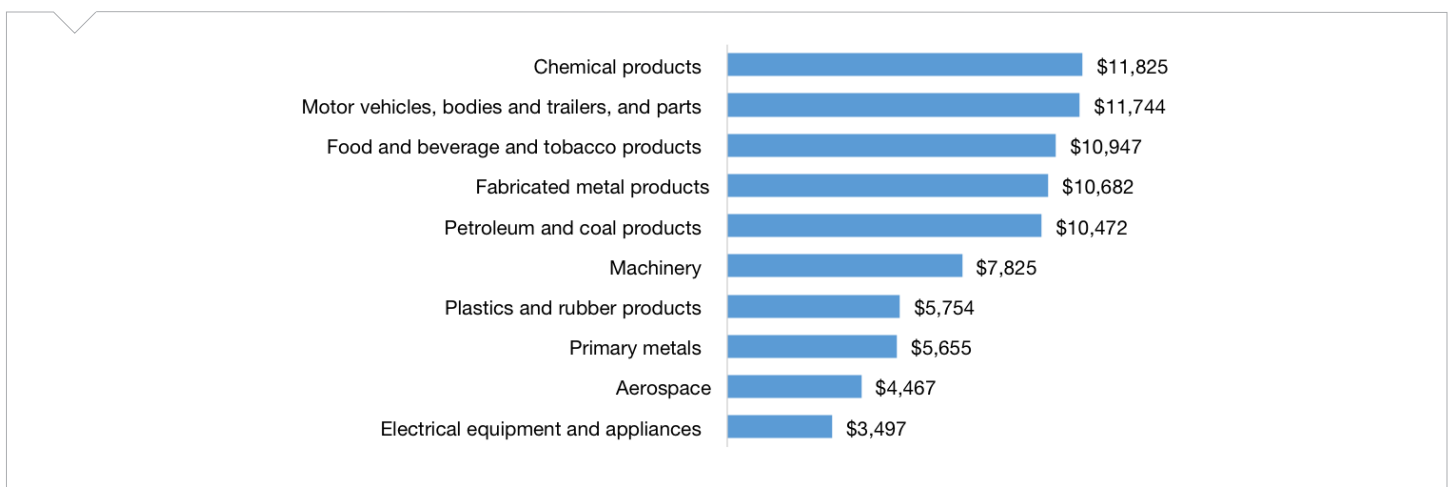


Figure 2: Top 10 Ohio Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



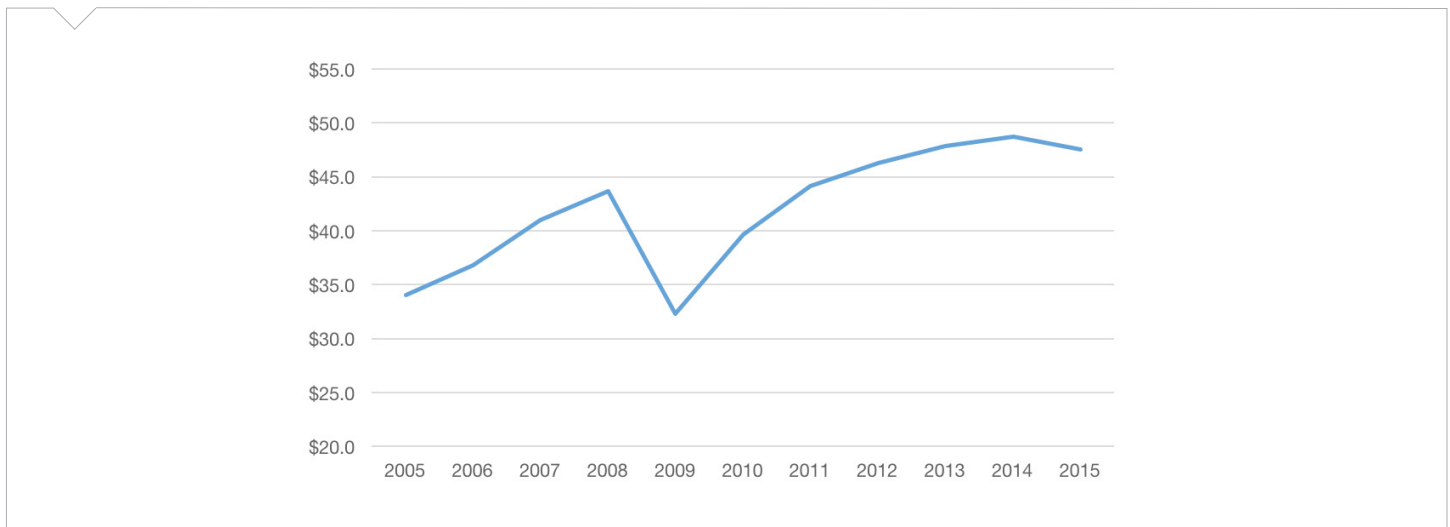
Ohio Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Ohio's economy, with \$47.56 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$29.35 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 27.6% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 89.4 percent of all exporters in Ohio.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
