## Virginia Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Virginia account for 9.2 percent of the total output in the state, employing 6.1 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$42.44 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 234,400 manufacturing employees in Virginia in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$68,697 in 2014.

Figure 1: Virginia Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014





Figure 2: Top 10 Virginia Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013




## Virginia Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Virginia's economy, with \$15.25 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$6.41 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 20.3% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 85.8 percent of all exporters in Virginia.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
