

Alaska Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Alaska account for 3 percent of the total output in the state, employing 4 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$1.60 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 13,500 manufacturing employees in Alaska in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$55,598 in 2015.

Figure 1: Alaska Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

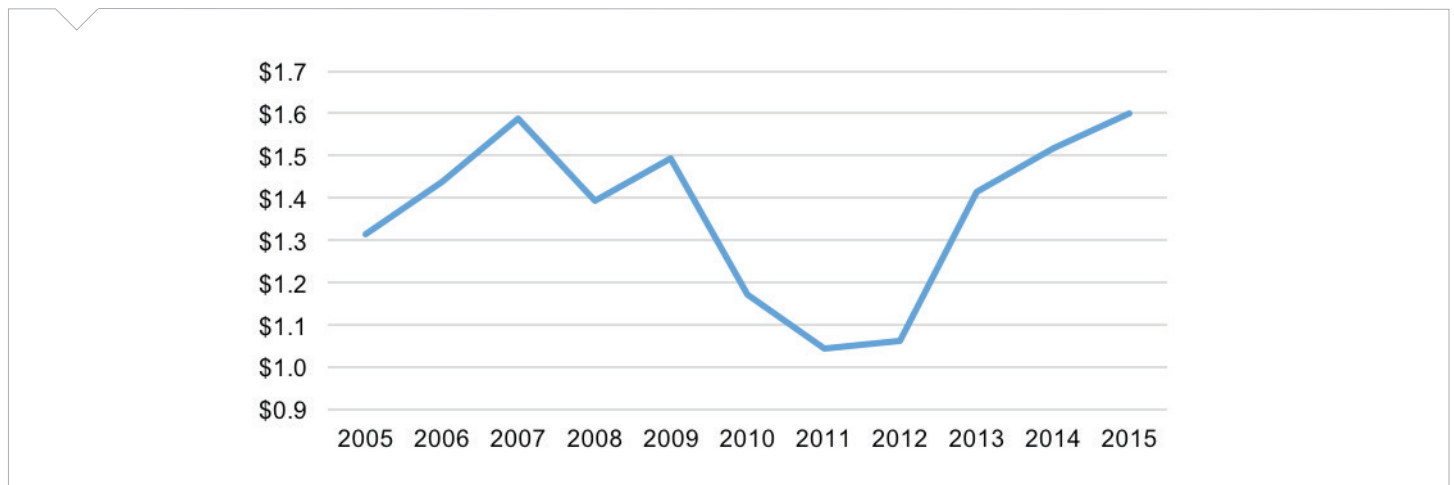
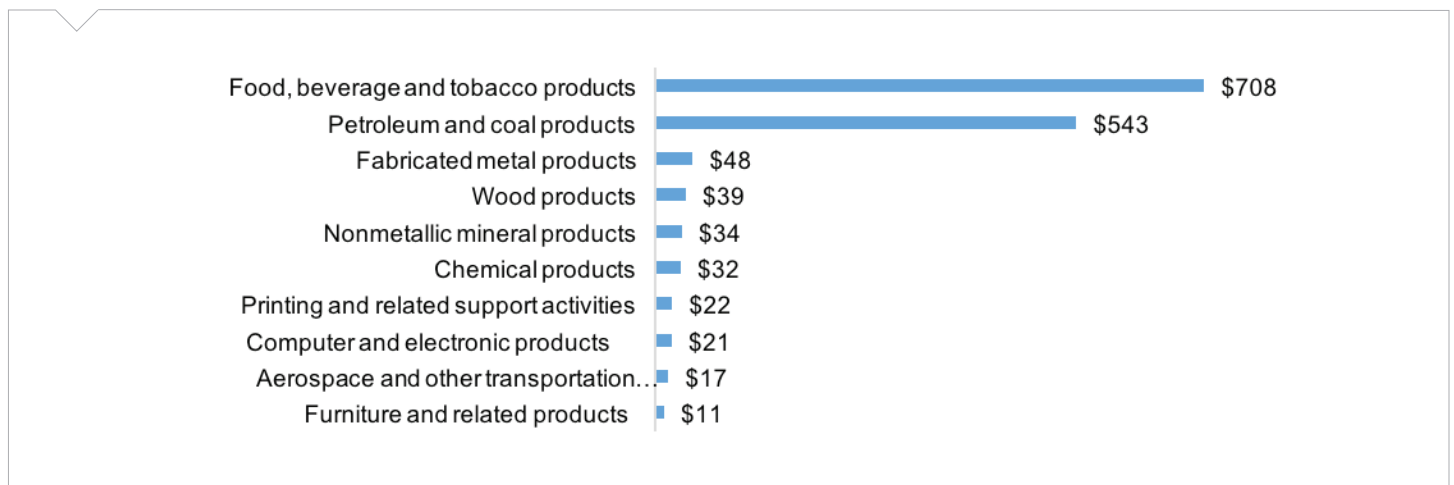


Figure 2: Top 10 Alaska Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



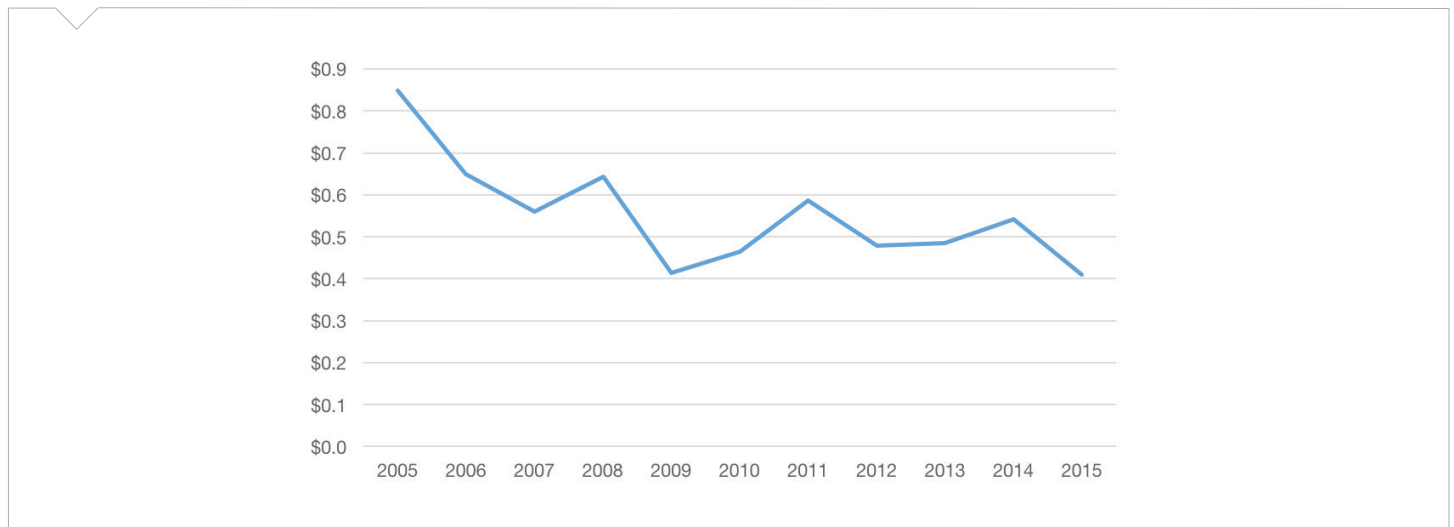
Alaska Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Alaska's economy, with \$0.41 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$0.19 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 30.60% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 72.6 percent of all exporters in Alaska.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
