

Georgia Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Georgia account for 11.1 percent of the total output in the state, employing 8.8 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$54.82 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 373,700 manufacturing employees in Georgia in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$67,365 in 2015.

Figure 1: Georgia Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

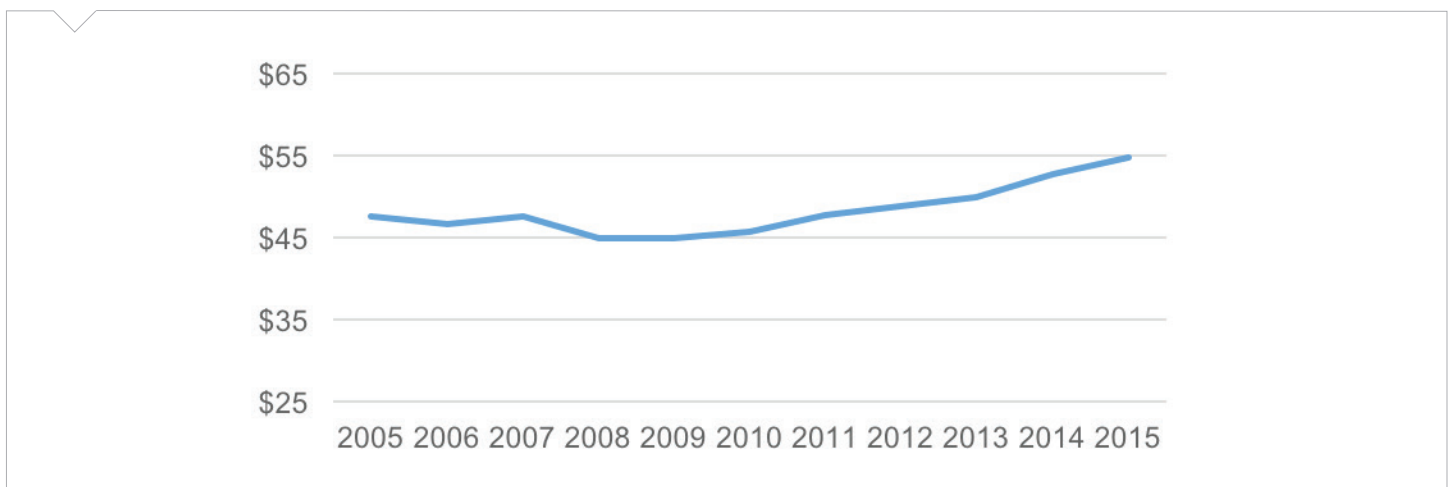
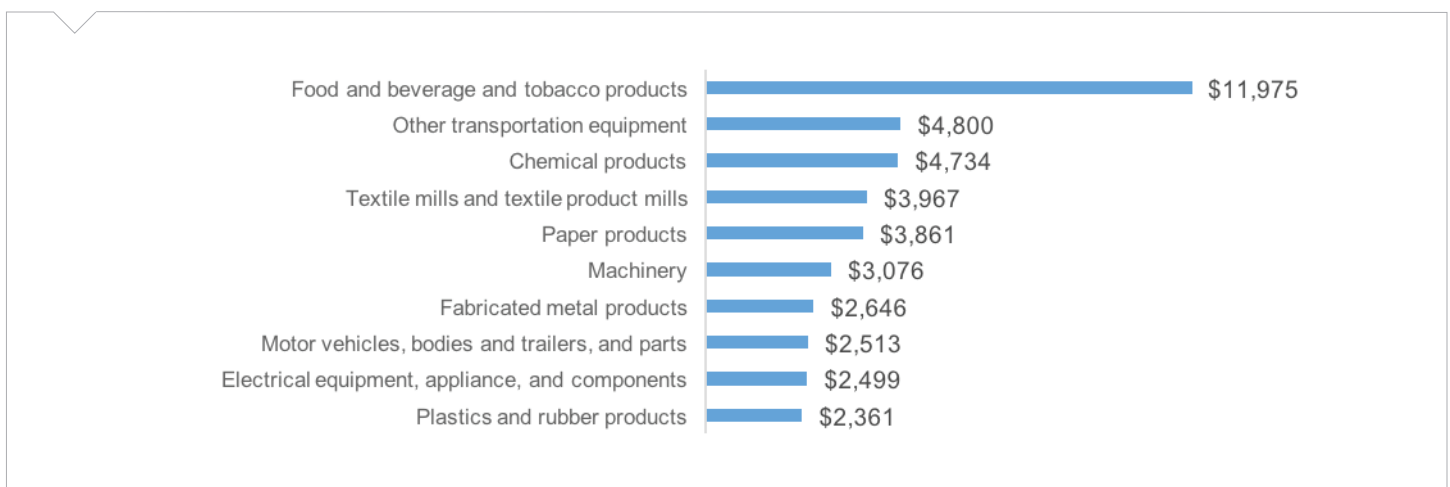


Figure 2: Top 10 Georgia Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



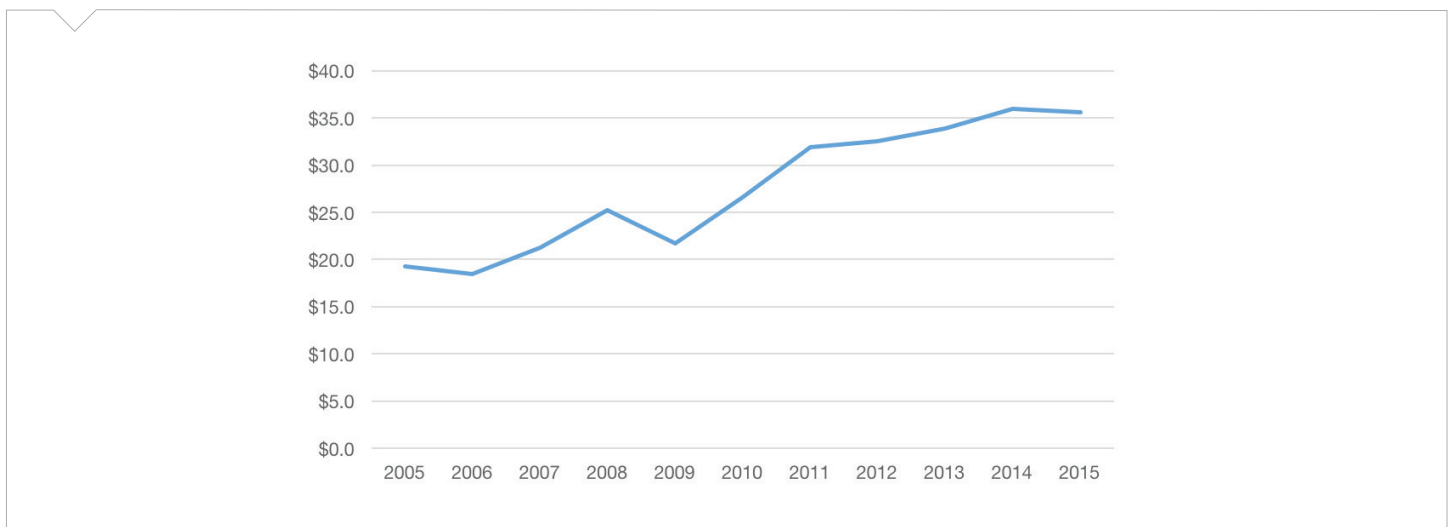
Georgia Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Georgia's economy, with \$35.60 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$14.85 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 21.30% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 88.8 percent of all exporters in Georgia.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
