Indiana Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Indiana account for 29.7 percent of the total output in the state, employing 17.1 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$99.96 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 519,300 manufacturing employees in Indiana in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$73,765 in 2015.

Figure 1: Indiana Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015





Figure 2: Top 10 Indiana Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014




Indiana Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Indiana's economy, with \$33.10 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$17.71 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 24.70% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 84.9 percent of all exporters in Indiana.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
