Michigan Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Michigan account for 19.8 percent of the total output in the state, employing 14 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$92.55 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 598,000 manufacturing employees in Michigan in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$77,277 in 2015.

Figure 1: Michigan Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015





Figure 2: Top 10 Michigan Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014




Michigan Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Michigan's economy, with \$50.08 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$35.10 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 30.70% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 89.3 percent of all exporters in Michigan.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
