Minnesota Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Minnesota account for 14.5 percent of the total output in the state, employing 11 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$48.21 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 314,900 manufacturing employees in Minnesota in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$74,360 in 2015.

Figure 1: Minnesota Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015





Figure 2: Top 10 Minnesota Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014




Minnesota Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Minnesota's economy, with \$18.88 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$8.59 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 22.40% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 87.1 percent of all exporters in Minnesota.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
