

Mississippi Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Mississippi account for 16.8 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.5 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$15.71 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 141,000 manufacturing employees in Mississippi in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$58,085 in 2015.

Figure 1: Mississippi Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

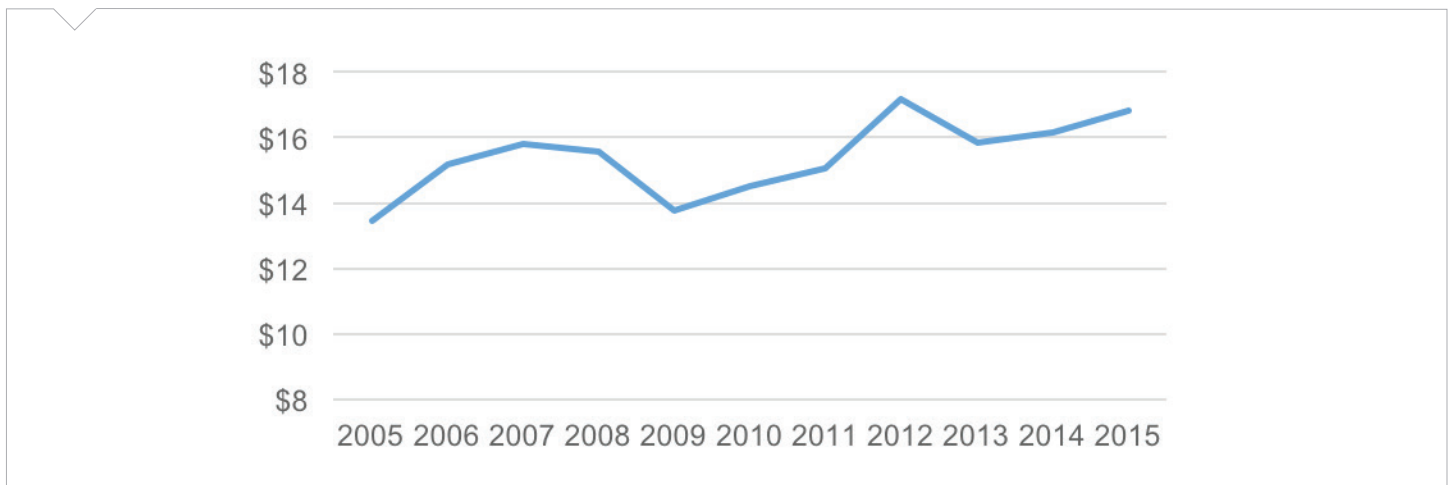
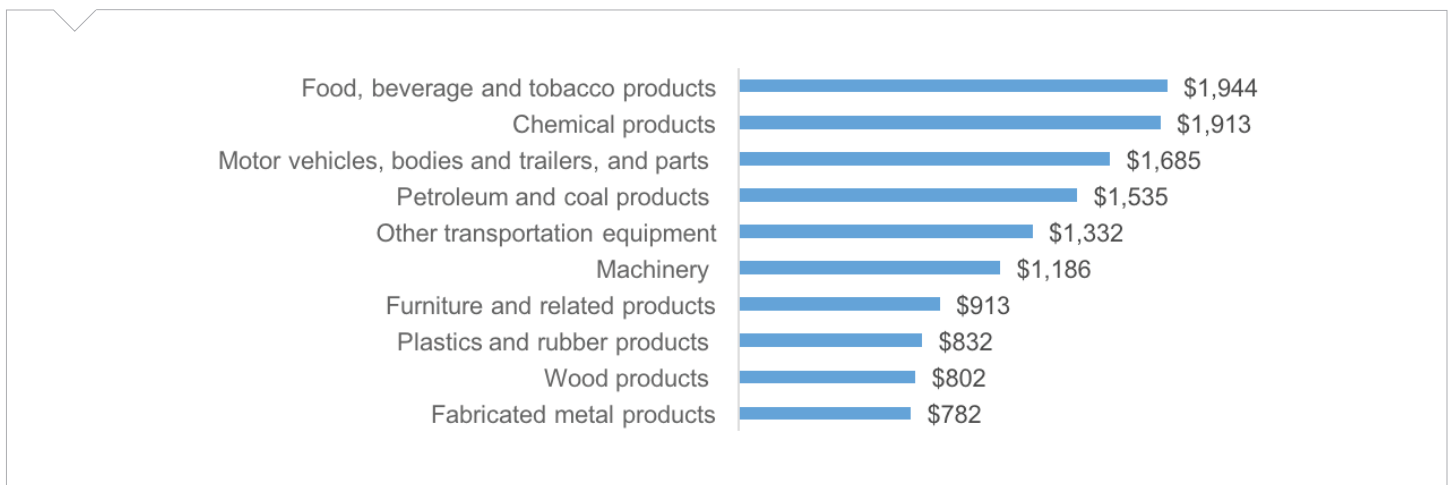


Figure 2: Top 10 Mississippi Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



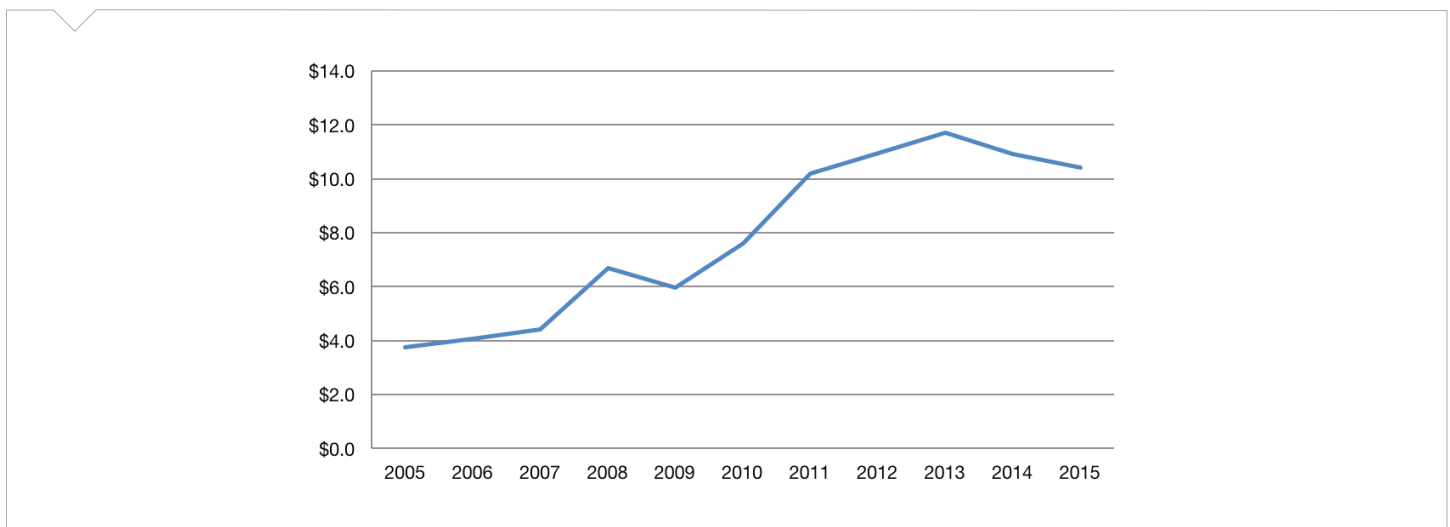
Mississippi Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Mississippi's economy, with \$10.40 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$6.47 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 13.60% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 76.2 percent of all exporters in Mississippi.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
