

Nevada Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Nevada account for 4.6 percent of the total output in the state, employing 3.4 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$6.54 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 42,000 manufacturing employees in Nevada in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$64,227 in 2015.

Figure 1: Nevada Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

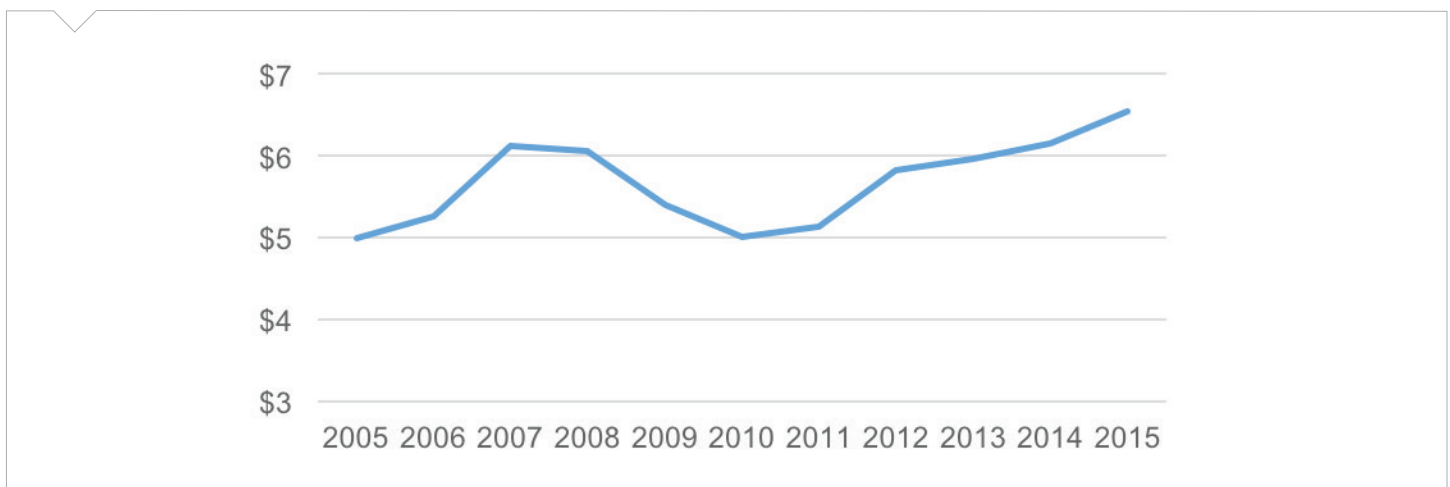
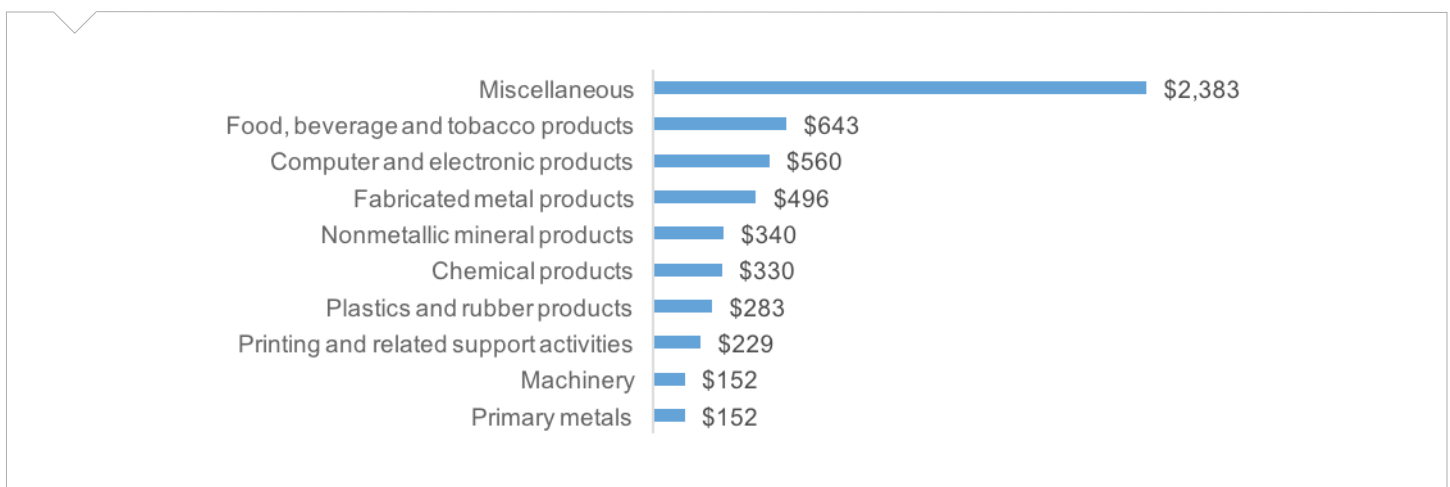


Figure 2: Top 10 Nevada Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



Nevada Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Nevada's economy, with \$8.19 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$2.09 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 17.40% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 86.2 percent of all exporters in Nevada.

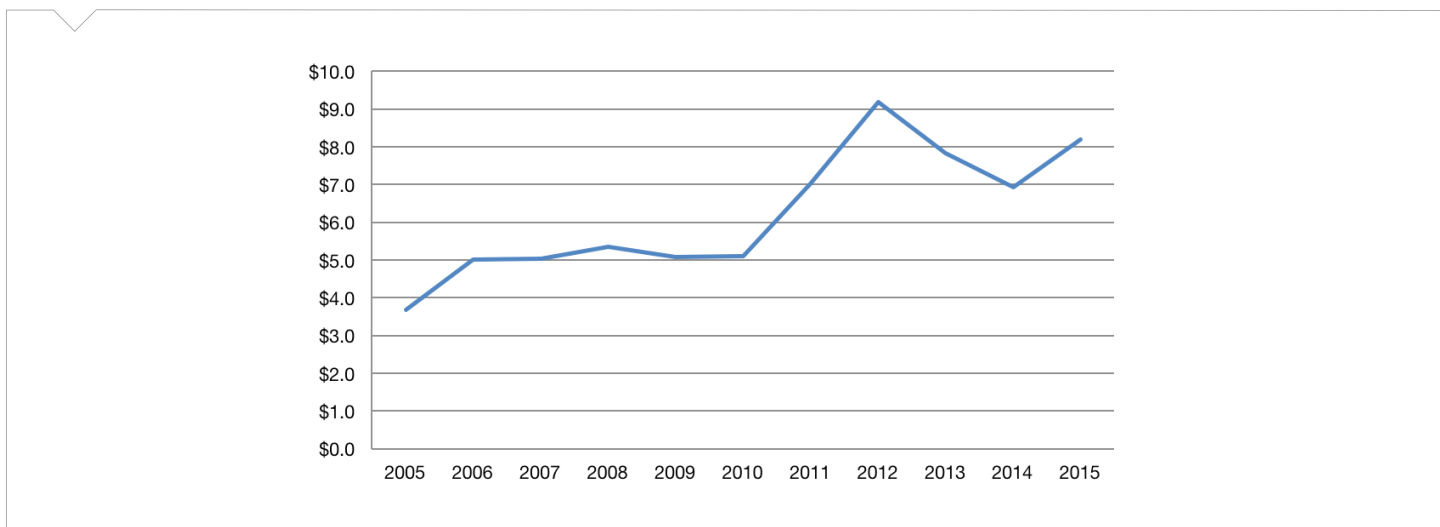

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
