Colorado Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Colorado account for 7.09 percent of the total output in the state, employing 5.55 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$21.74 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 140,100 manufacturing employees in Colorado in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$71,145 in 2013.

Figure 1: Colorado Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014





Figure 2: Top 10 Colorado Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013





Manufacturers help to drive Colorado's economy, with \$7.71 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$3.30 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 24.00% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 87.8 percent of all exporters in Colorado.
