

Oklahoma Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Oklahoma account for 9.55 percent of the total output in the state, employing 8.04 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$17.53 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 133,400 manufacturing employees in Oklahoma in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$62,549 in 2013.

Figure 1: Oklahoma Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

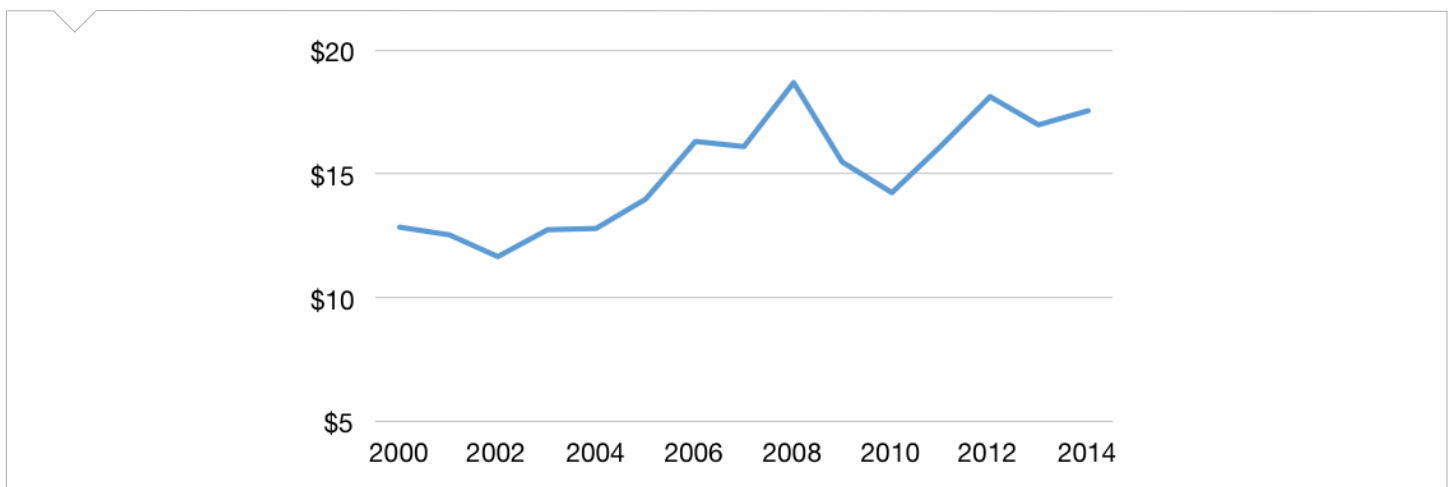
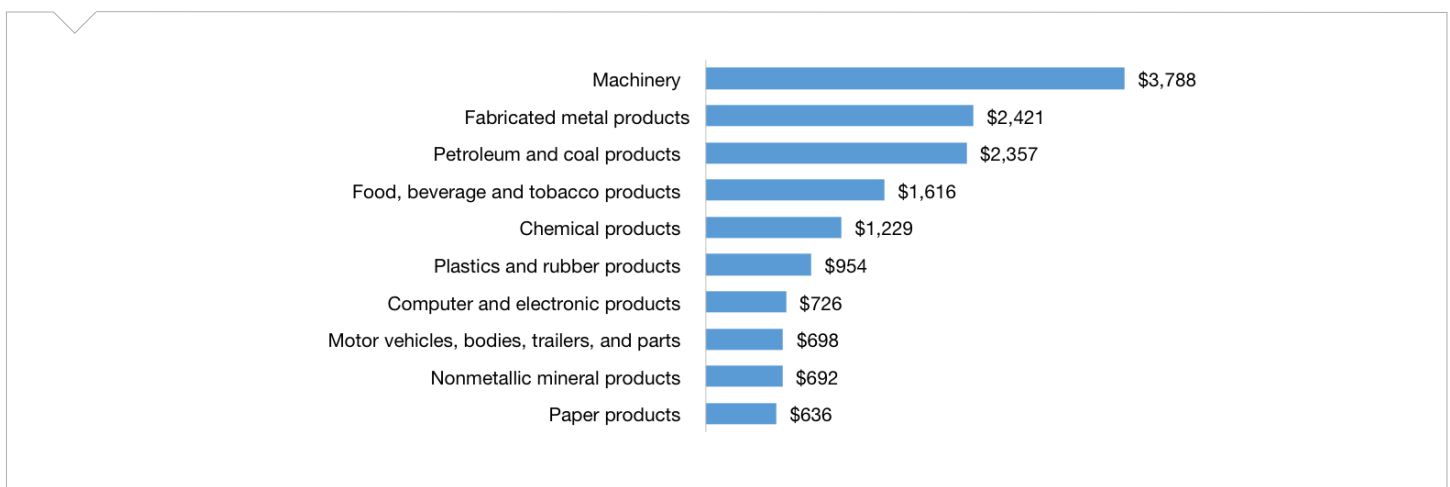


Figure 2: Top 10 Oklahoma Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



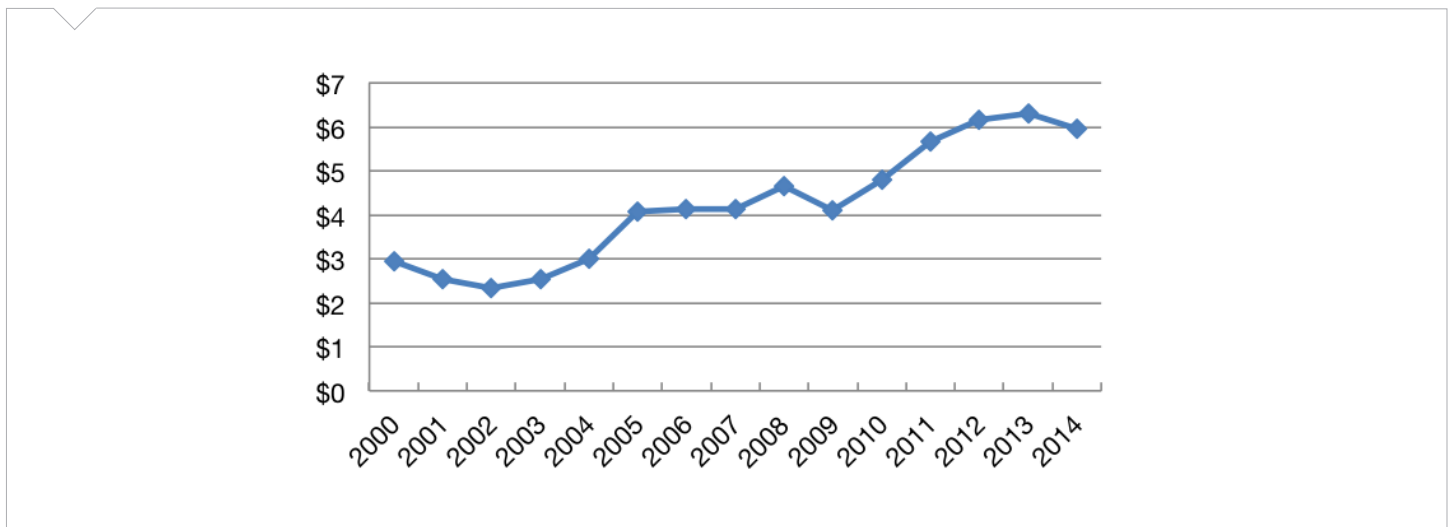
Oklahoma Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Oklahoma's economy, with \$5.96 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$3.10 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 19.50% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 84.6 percent of all exporters in Oklahoma.

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
