

Alaska Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Alaska account for 2.44 percent of the total output in the state, employing 3.88 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$1.39 billion in 2014. In addition, there were 13,100 manufacturing employees in Alaska in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$51,557 in 2013.

Figure 1: Alaska Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2000–2014

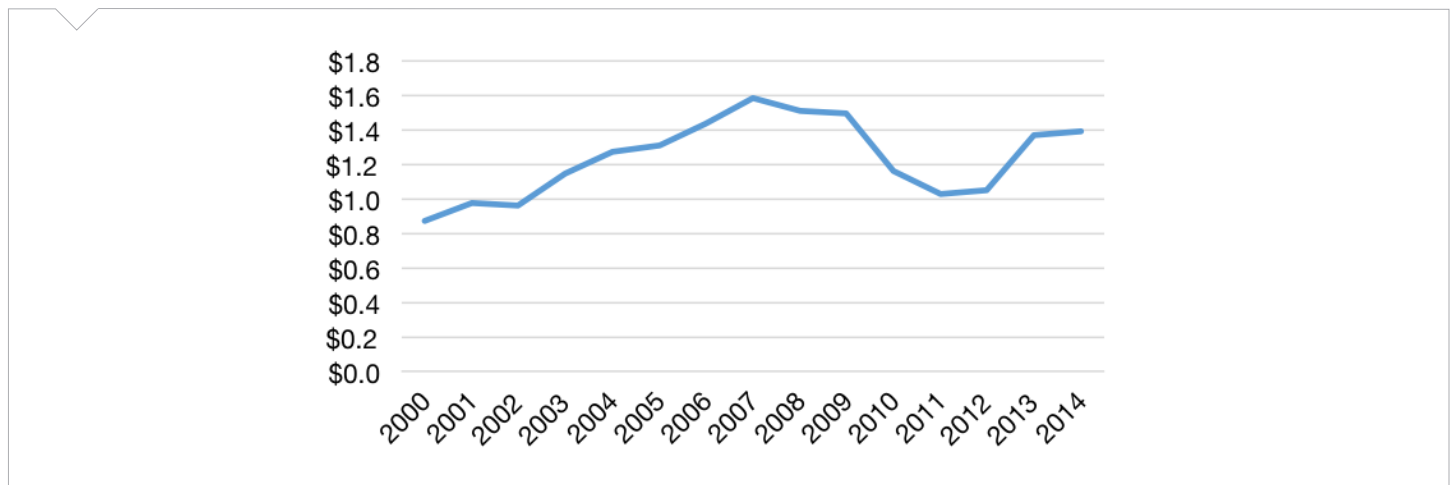
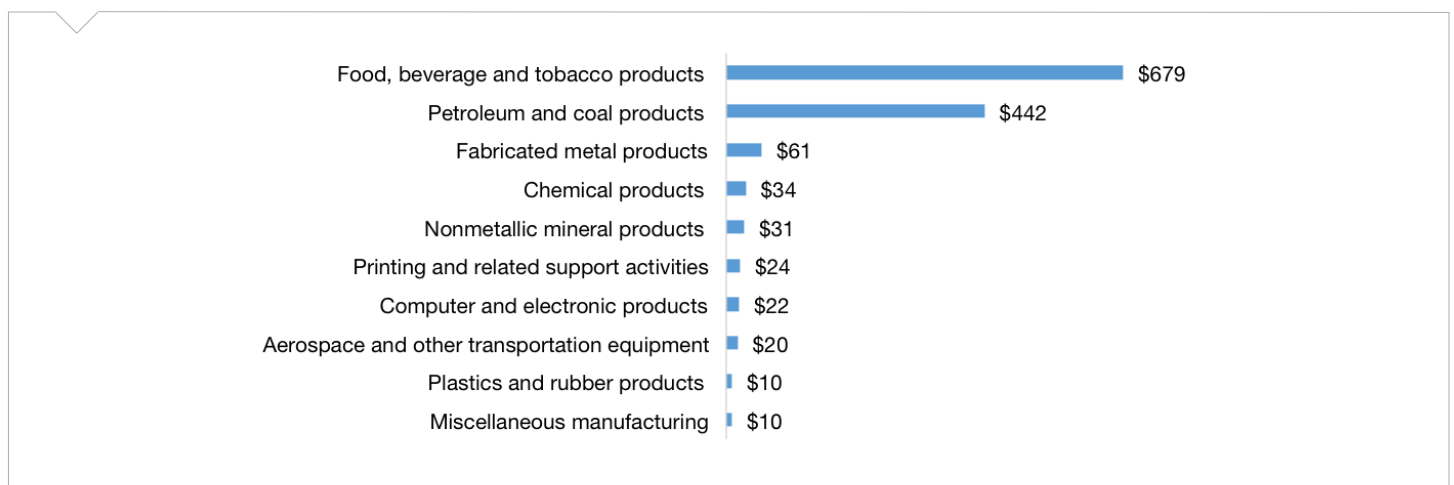


Figure 2: Top 10 Alaska Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2013



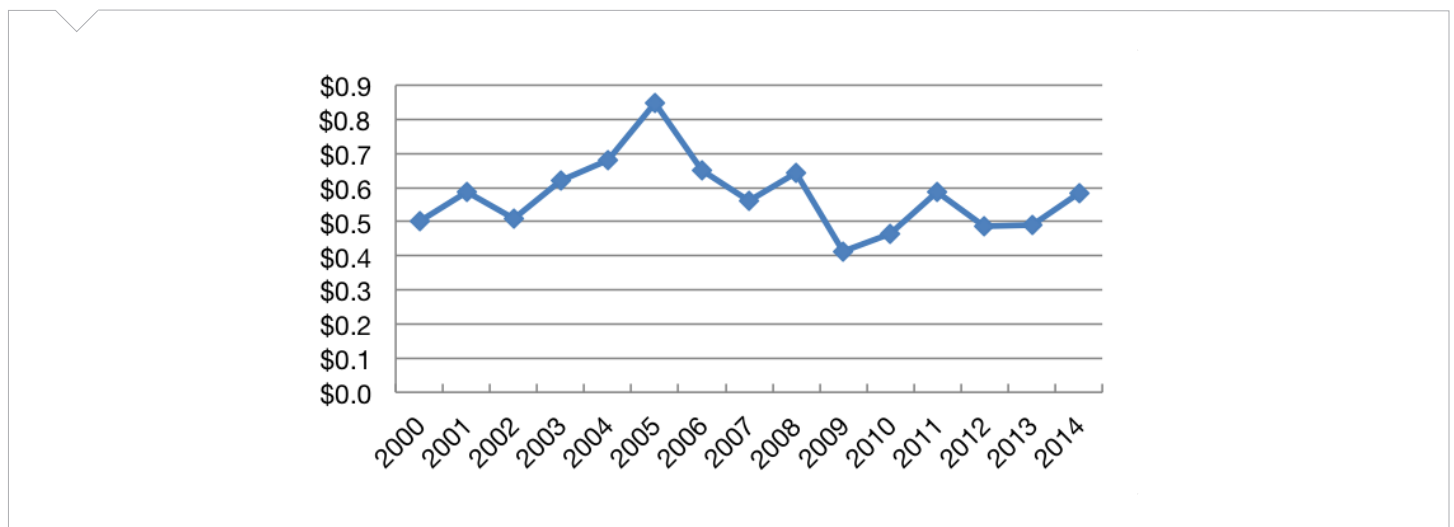
Alaska Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Alaska's economy, with \$0.58 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2014. That same year, \$0.33 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 30.60% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 72.6 percent of all exporters in Alaska.

- In 2014, manufacturers in the United States sold \$55.0 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$579.2 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
