# **Arkansas** Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Arkansas account for 15.1 percent of the total output in the state, employing 12.7 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$18.82 billion in 2017. In addition, there were 158.6 manufacturing employees in Arkansas in 2017, with an average annual compensation of \$56,728 in 2016.

**Figure 1:** Arkansas Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars. 2005–2017




Figure 2: Top 10 Arkansas Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2016





Figure 3: Top 25 Manufacturing Job Titles over the Past 12 Months in Arkansas





## **Arkansas** Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Arkansas's economy, with \$5.81 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2017. That same year, \$2.60 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 14.1 percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 80 percent of all exporters in Arkansas.
