

Hawaii Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Hawaii account for 1.8 percent of the total output in the state, employing 2.1 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$1.45 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 13,500 manufacturing employees in Hawaii in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$43,928 in 2015.

Figure 1: Hawaii Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

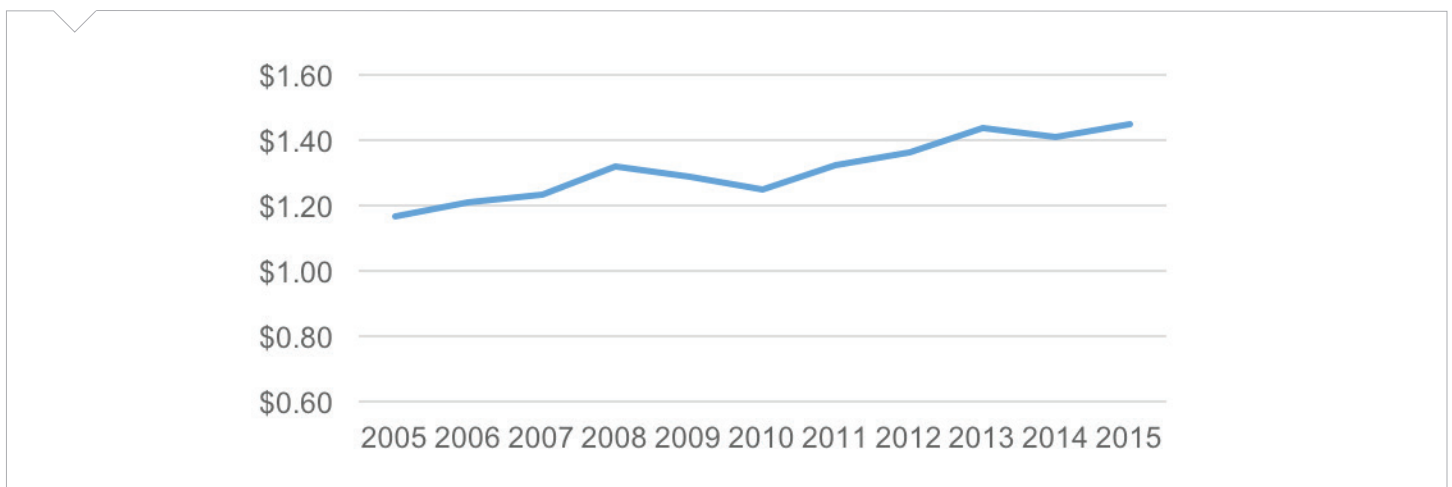
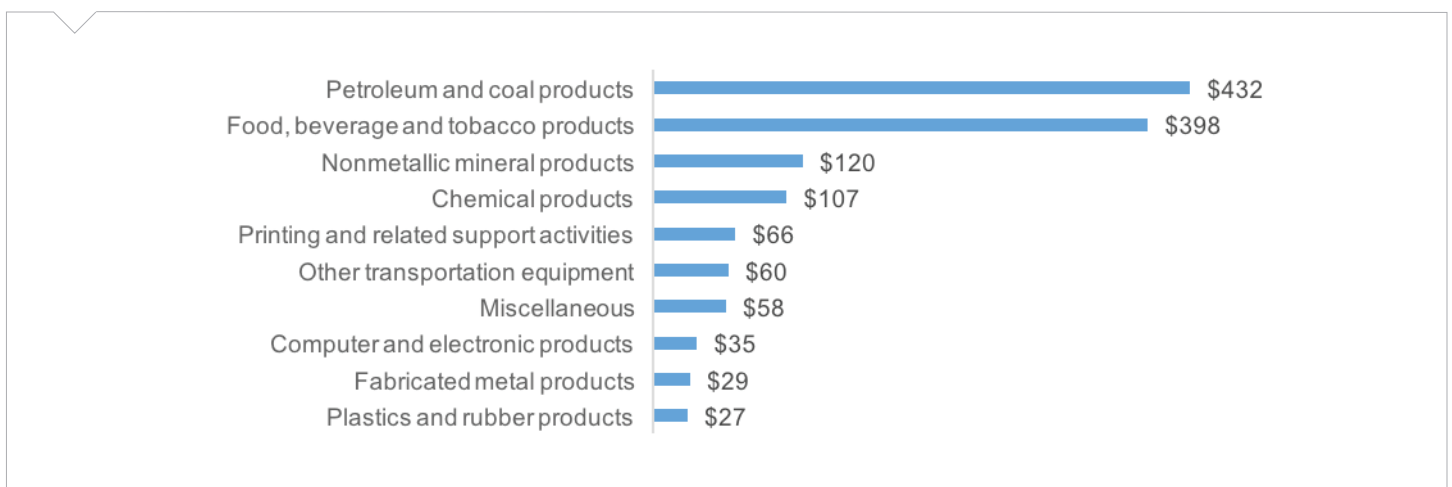


Figure 2: Top 10 Hawaii Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



Hawaii Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Hawaii's economy, with \$1.73 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$1.52 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 4.70% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 85.8 percent of all exporters in Hawaii.

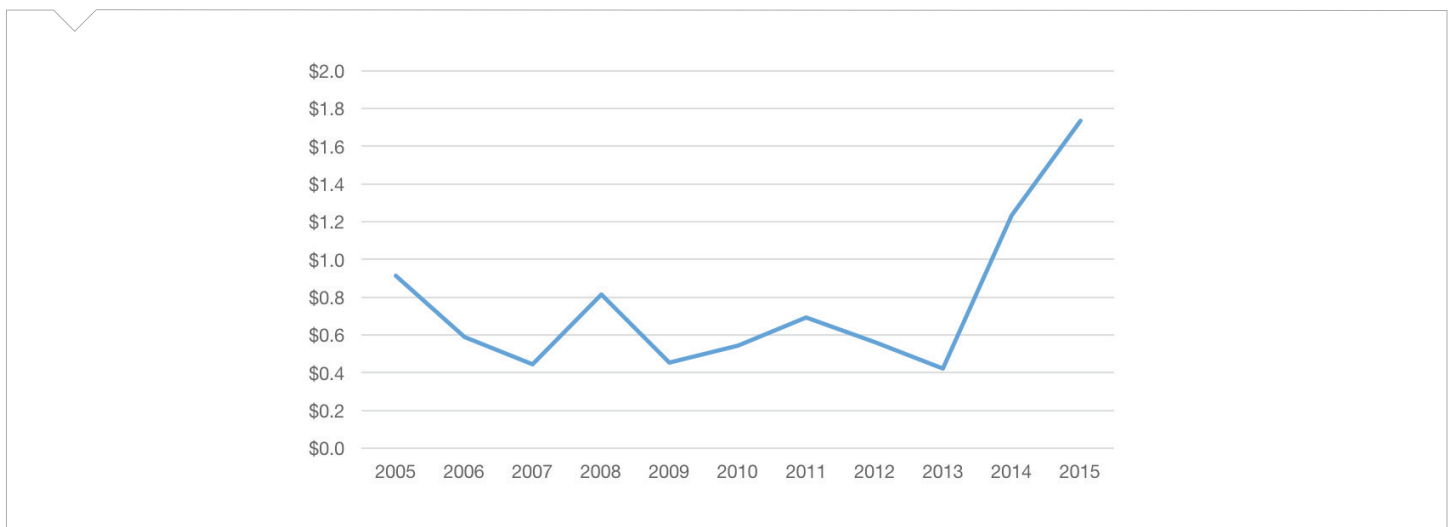

Additional Trade Facts

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
