

Illinois Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Illinois account for 13.4 percent of the total output in the state, employing 9.7 percent of the workforce. Total output from manufacturing was \$103.76 billion in 2015. In addition, there were 572,500 manufacturing employees in Illinois in 2015, with an average annual compensation of \$84,138 in 2015.

Figure 1: Illinois Manufacturing Output, in Billions of Dollars, 2005–2015

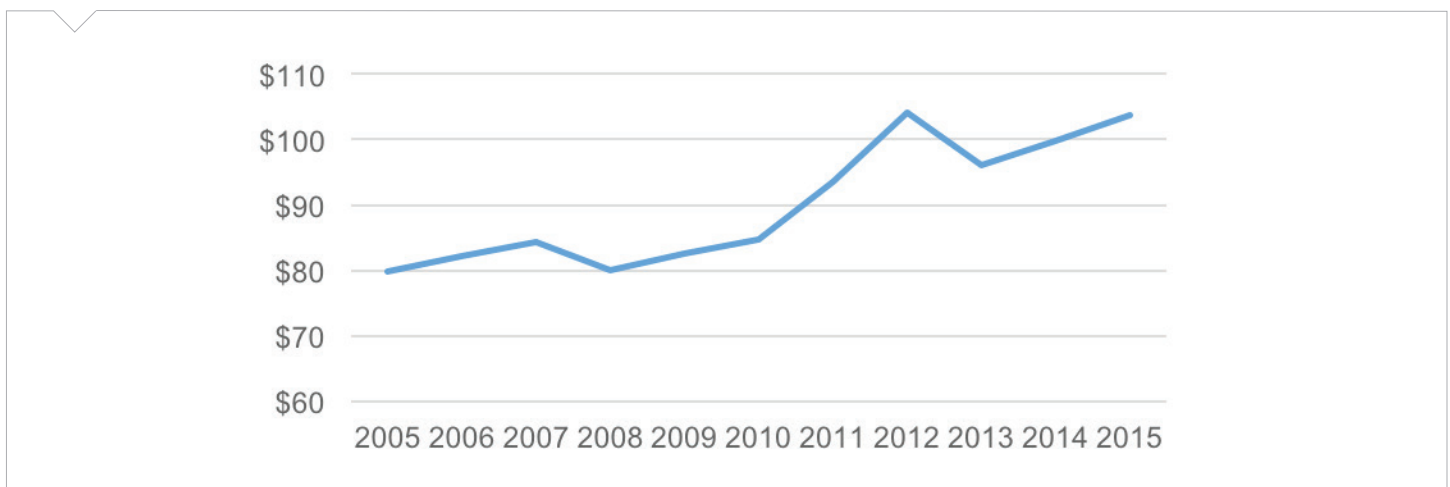
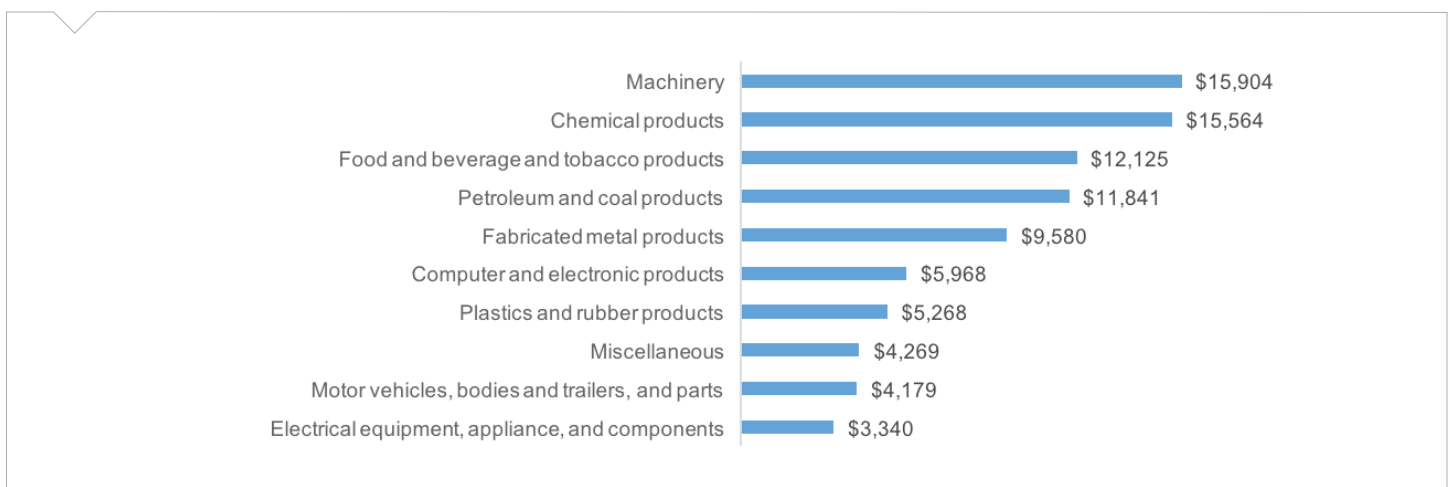


Figure 2: Top 10 Illinois Manufacturing Sectors, in Millions of Dollars, 2014



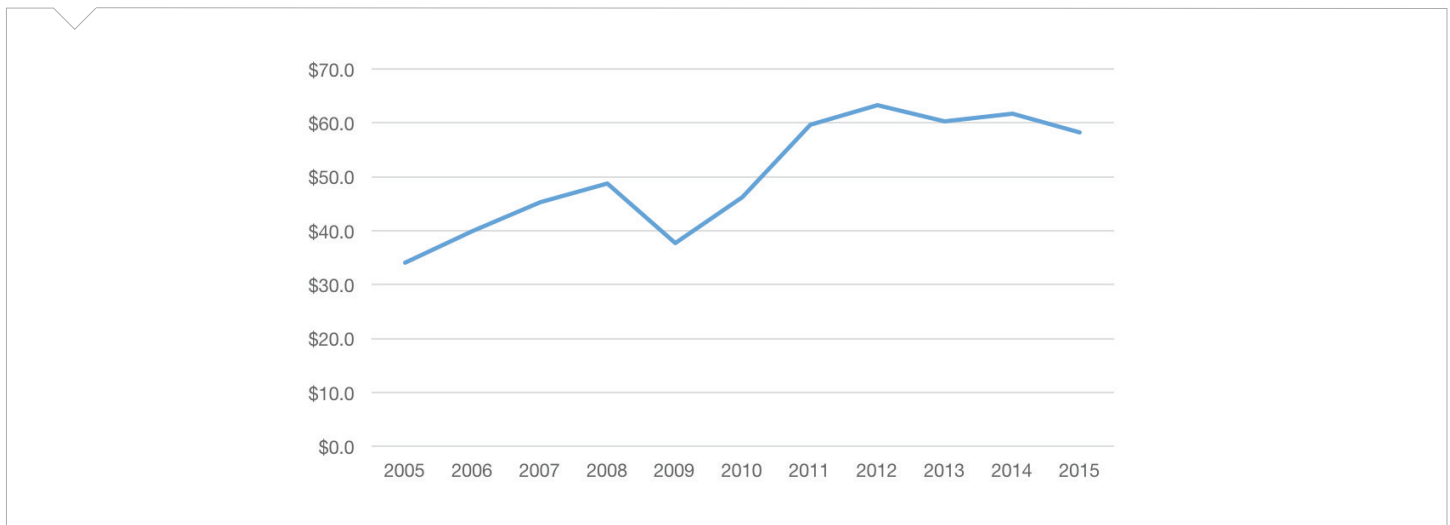
Illinois Export Facts

Manufacturers help to drive Illinois's economy, with \$58.26 billion in manufactured goods exports in 2015. That same year, \$32.16 billion in exports was with our free trade agreement (FTA) partners. This helps create jobs in the state, and 26.90% percent of its employment stemmed from exports in 2011. Small businesses comprised 90 percent of all exporters in Illinois.

- In 2015, manufacturers in the United States sold \$12.7 billion more in manufactured goods to our FTA partners than we bought from them. The United States has a manufactured trade deficit of \$639.6 billion from countries where no FTAs existed.
