

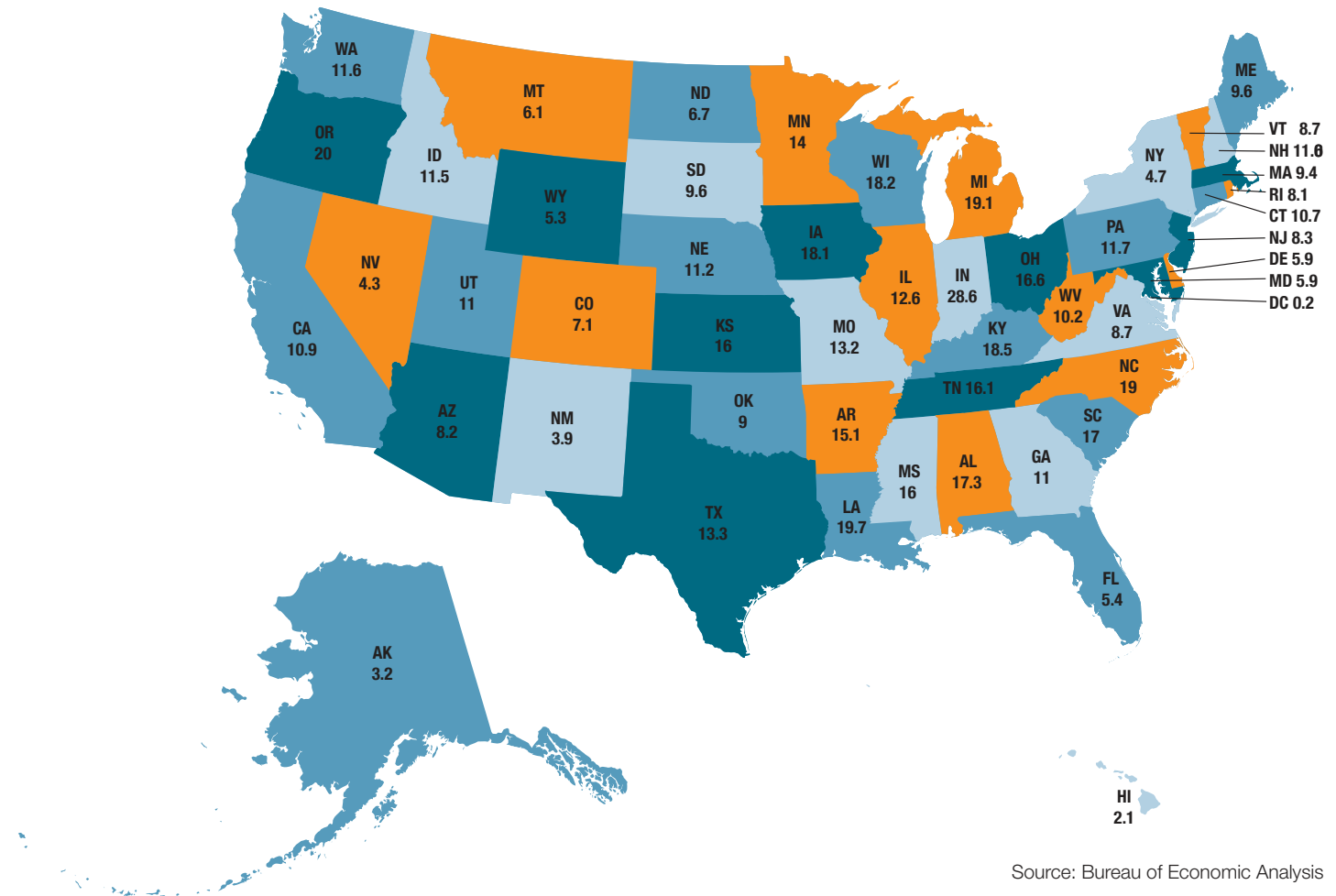
# Manufacturing's Share of Gross State Product

Manufacturing plays a significant role in our national economy, accounting for roughly 12 percent of U.S. GDP. At the state level, manufacturers make equally significant contributions, although some states play a larger role than others.

The map shows manufacturing's share of gross state product (GSP) for each state in 2017.
